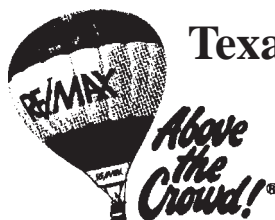

Basketball goals....include a copy of your recorded lot survey indicating the proposed location where you wish to install the goal.

It's a real easy process and takes no time at all to adhere to your governing documents. You can apply by mail, fax or email – whichever is easiest for you.

Dear Fairfield Neighbors,

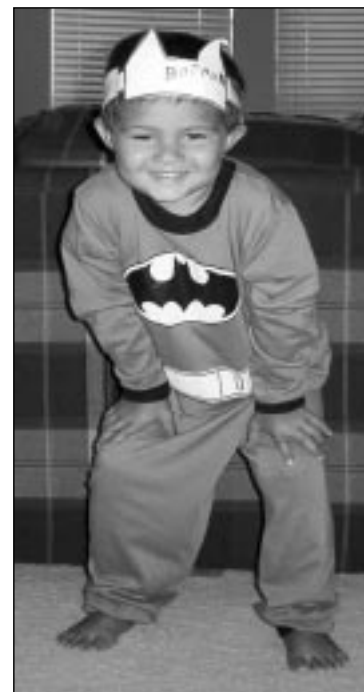

## Moms In Touch International

Every week, in every state of the U.S. and in 85 countries around the world, thousands of mothers meet to pray for their children and their schools. They gather in Mexico, New Zealand, China, Germany, India, Uganda, Egypt, Romania, Russia and many other countries. They are all part of *Moms In Touch International*, an interdenominational, nonprofit ministry of women who believe prayer makes a difference.

The group was founded in 1984 by Fern Nichols while she was stationed in Abbotsford, British Columbia with a Christian ministry. She had two sons entering junior high school. Nichols knew her boys were going to face their greatest test yet in resisting immoral values, vulgar language, and peer pressure. She found other concerned mothers, and they began meeting for prayer.

The following summer Nichols and her family moved to Poway, California, where by the fall of 1985, a group was established at Poway High School. The women met once a week and prayed for a full hour for their children and the school. They prayed for a *Moms In Touch* group for every school in their district, and they shared the concept with their friends and other moms they met. Two years later, Nichols published a *Moms In Touch* booklet, and the following January the first *Moms In Touch* retreat was held. Today there are thousands of *Moms In Touch* groups meeting worldwide.

The organization's goal is to have a group of two or more moms praying for every school in this country and throughout the world. We know our children face many challenges at school (academics, drugs, peer pressure and violence), and to stand in the gap for them through prayer is our highest calling.

The mothers meet once a week to pray for teachers, principals and administrators, conferences, respect for authority, curriculum choices, holiday situations, coaches and athletic programs, high standards, family values, after school programs, problems faced by the students and for the specific needs of the children of the mothers in the group.

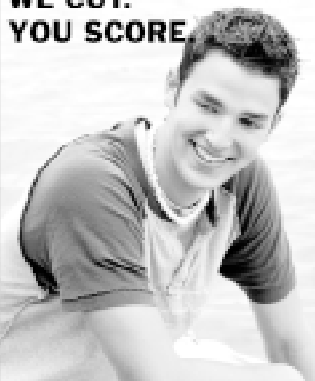

## GAZETTE SPOTLIGHT

**Q: What do you teach at FDC?**

A: Since the studio has opened I have taught a little bit of everything - ballet, pointe, tap, jazz, technique, conditioning and hip hop for students of all ages.

## Cy-Fair Band Program

One of the advantages of living in the Cy Fair School District is their commitment to the school music programs. The band program is outstanding. Instrumental music begins in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade where each day students have one period of music instruction grouped within the specific instruments. For example, the flutes learn together, as do the clarinets, the trumpets, the low brass and percussion. After 36 weeks of 45 minutes a day, the student has learned many aspects of the instrument and musicianship. The students then progress to the 4 bands leveled for ability.

Mrs. Pricilla Bell, the band director of Goodson Middle School said that currently there are 165 beginning band students and 235 continuing students divided into the 4 bands. This is the largest middle school program in the district. Mrs. Bell said, "We are busting at the band seams and we love it!" They have 2 other directors, Mr. Alex Hinojosa and Ms. Nicole Huerta. Throughout their middle school experience the students are able to participate in UIL contests for the bands, in which they are rated against a state wide standard with "1" being a superior rating. These bands have consistently been rated superior since the school opened in 2001. The students are also encouraged to perform in individual competitions such as solo and ensemble festivals. Goodson walked away with 200 medals this past year. Many of the students also audition for Region Band and earn a spot. One of the highlights for the year is when the 8<sup>th</sup> graders are able to perform at a Cy-Fair football game in the stands along side the Cy-Fair High School marching band. This sets the stage for their freshman year in which they are on the field performing at halftime.

Mr. Mark Veenstra, director of the band program at the Cy-Fair High School always looks forward to each years band. This years band consists of 280 students. The directors spend a lot of time choosing the program and watching it come together. To watch the progression of the initial practices with all the students trying to learn their music and move to their designated spots for their performances on the football field, you can see all the hard work, practice and dedication that go into making Cy-Fair Marching Band one of the most respected bands in the area.

One of the exciting things for the band students is the cohesiveness. Practice begins in late July and by the time school starts, many freshmen have already made new friends. There is the big sister/big brother program which connects an upperclassman to an incoming freshman. There are the traditional get-togethers including skating parties, swim parties, lock-ins and a semi formal band banquet at the end of the year. All the students perform at the varsity football games and the competition band performs at area marching band competitions throughout the season.

The color guard is a very big part of the marching band, their graceful movements with flags, rifles and swords adds to the overall performance. The color guard, under the direction of Mr. Jeremy Baudoin , continue to perform in winter competitions and this past year placed 18th in the world in their division in San Diego, CA.

After football season, all the band students continue with their 5 different leveled bands under the direction of Mr. Mark Veenstra, Mr. Skip Martin, Ms. Shirley Holstein and Mr. Chris Young. Students continue to compete in UIL competitions, solo and ensemble competitions and other band competitions throughout the U.S. Many audition and earn a spot for Region Band, Area Band and All State Band. Last school year, all the bands performed in San Antonio for the Bluebonnet Classic Band Festival and won sweepstakes in all categories. Band continues to be part of the lives for many Cy-Fair students after graduation. Many of the band's serious musicians go on to college and major in music, with some receiving full scholarships. Some students major in other areas and perform with the college marching or symphonic bands.

Cy-Fair's Marching Band performed in the 1999 Rose Bowl Parade and are awaiting acceptance to perform in the 2006 parade. This would be a wonderful experience for the students and for the residents of the Cy-Fair School District. We will keep you posted!!

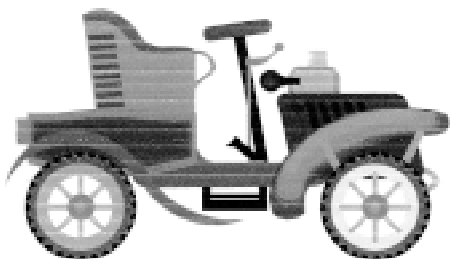
## **CY-FAIR KIWANIS CLUB OF HOUSTON**

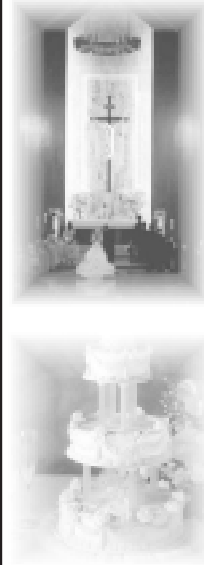

## Harvest Bible Church

In chapters 2-3 of the Book of Revelation Jesus Christ addressed seven first-century churches. In each church he encouraged what was good and rebuked what was wrong in their midst. At the end of each discourse he said, "He who has an ear let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." In other words, what Jesus said to those churches applies to all churches.

All churches today do some things well and some things not-so-well. But the things we do not-so-well must never be excused and relegated to "we're only human!" for Jesus severely rebukes our shortcomings. Since the church itself is the actual body of Christ, it *should* be perfect, that is, above reproach in its character. For those who call themselves Christians Jesus commends hard work in laboring to teach the Scriptures, perseverance under trial and persecution, no toleration of evil men and evil practices within the church, the testing false prophets, and spiritual growth in the face of financial poverty. Jesus also commends those who are willing to die for the sake of his name. And in the first century this was the norm.

Now Jesus also rebukes sinful behavior in the church. Jesus severely rebukes those who obey God but have no love for Him, those who tolerate others in the church who live in sin as well as those who tolerate false teachers – those who teach things contrary to the Scriptures. He severely rebuke churches who have good reputations from the past but who have no spiritual life in the present. And he most severely rebuke churches with spiritual indifference – churches that are "lukewarm." Rev.

3:16 says that these kinds of churches make him want to vomit! How does indifference enter into a church? Through excessive riches which cause us to believe that all is well when it really isn't. This describes so many churches today. Our material wealth makes us indifferent to our need for the Savior.

Let all churches today who read this take inventory of their spiritual life. Even though all Christian churches have something to commend, we can always be better. Jesus even warned the churches of the first century that if they didn't fix what was wrong he would come and take their churches away from them. He meant business! The bottom line is that we are the body of Jesus Christ, and as a result of our many shortcomings and our indifference to them we tend to make a mockery of Jesus Christ. Let us go forth and represent him the way He was intended to be represented – in truth! That truth, and all the rest of the answers to life, is found in the Bible – the pure word of God. In it *alone* will you find the answer to eternal life in heaven with God.

## Fruitful Word Ministries

Someone posed the question to me this week, "What one right would you have the most difficulty giving up for a day?" My immediate response was, "The right to be treated with respect." After all, Scripture tells us to consider others better than ourselves. Each person was created by God with value and purpose. Yes, being treated with respect is certainly a reasonable expectation. "Everyone has the right to be treated with dignity as a child of God," I thought. Yet as I spoke those words, I had that uncomfortable feeling in my spirit I've learned to recognize as the Holy Spirit's conviction.

My thoughts flashed to Jesus standing in Pilate's court as the crowd shouted, "Crucify him!" (Mark 15:12-13). Hardly respect. Soldiers mocked Jesus, thrust the crown of thorns upon his brow and struck him with a staff. They even spit on him! Not a word of rebuke left Jesus' lips.

When the nails pierced our Lord's hands and He was crucified as a common criminal, Jesus' only request was "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing" (Luke 23:34). Not once did Jesus demand respect. He was the Son of God. He was El Shaddai — an all sufficient, powerful God. If anyone had the right to be treated with respect, it was He.

*Philippians 2:5-8 says: Your attitude should be the same that Christ Jesus had. Though he was God, he did not demand and cling to his rights as God. He made himself nothing; he took the humble position of a slave and appeared in human form. And in human form he obediently humbled himself even further by dying a criminal's death on a cross. (NLT)*

Like me, do you feel entitled to a certain level of respect? Maybe you cling to the right to make your own decisions. Perhaps you expect to enjoy the comforts our society offers. But our Lord encountered contempt more often than reverence. As He prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus relinquished His choice to avoid the crucifixion. And as our Savior hung on

the cross, He abandoned His comfort so we could one day enjoy the eternal luxuries of Heaven.

What right do you have difficulty relinquishing? I challenge you to let go of that right for a week. Make a conscious effort to take on the submissive attitude of Christ. It promises to be a humbling experience.

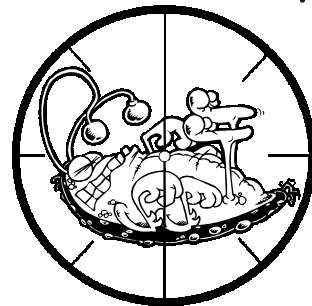

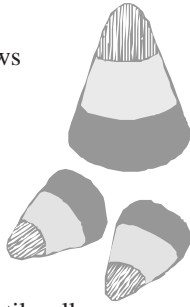
