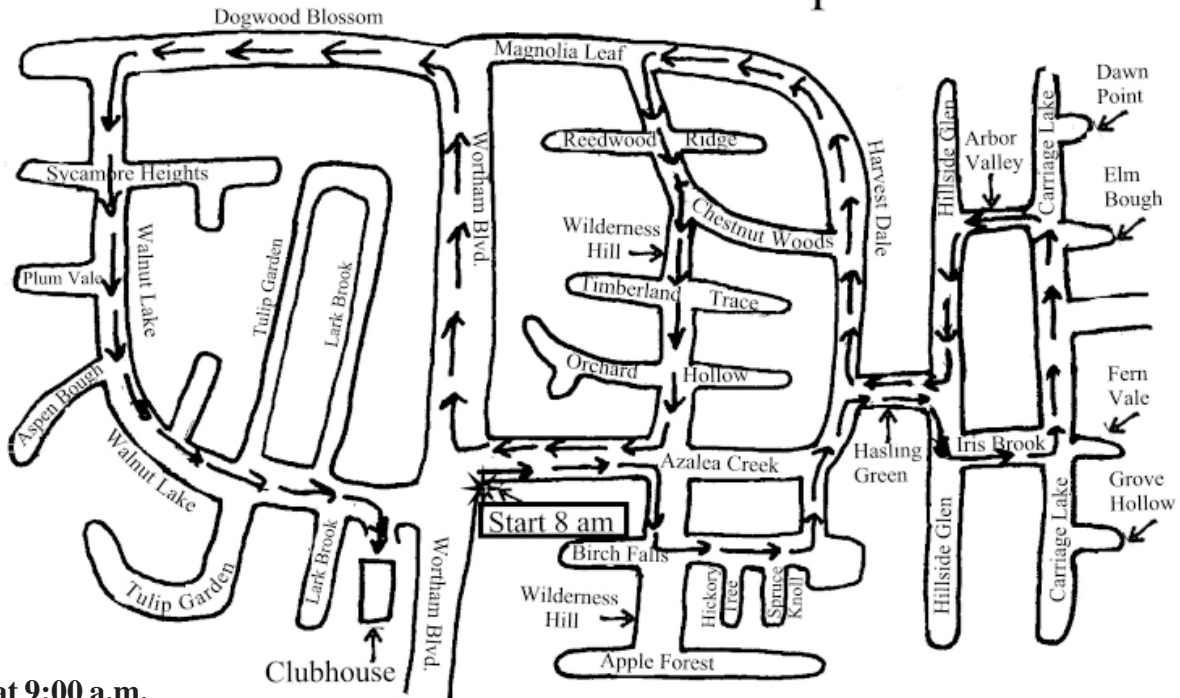

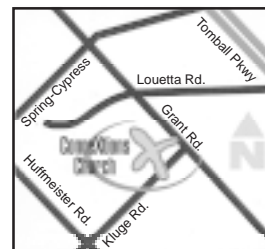

Girl Scout Gold Award for Tommi Jo Scott

Tommi Jo Scott has attended School of the Woods since 1994, second grade. She is now a senior at Woods High School and has just completed and approved to receive her Girl Scout Gold Award, which will be presented to her during the Girl Scout Court of Awards Ceremony in April. Tommi Jo's Girl Scout Gold Award Project was centered on helping Cypress Ministries Angel's Attic collect necessity items focusing on paper products and collecting primarily during the summer. Summers are the toughest time for Angel's Attic because more items are needed but less is donated because the community's unawareness to the need. Also these items are not eligible for purchase with food stamps. Tommi Jo brought awareness to those needs by holding six collection events the past year, including one at School of the Woods. She collected over 2000 products and over 1000 paper products.

Tommi Jo learned that motivation was a big part of success because things wouldn't get done if she didn't take charge. She chose this project because she felt that she needed to help those who are unable to purchase necessities due to lack of funds. Her family felt that she learned to better appreciate the advantages she has had growing up when compared to other families that cannot afford to buy even the most common, everyday things. As a result of planning, implementing her project, she has become better organized.

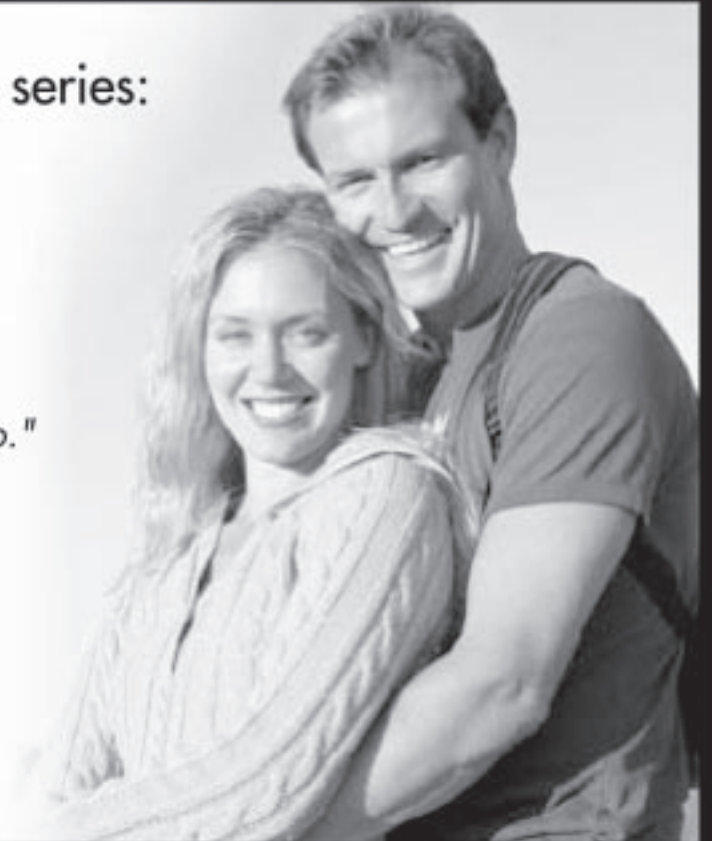

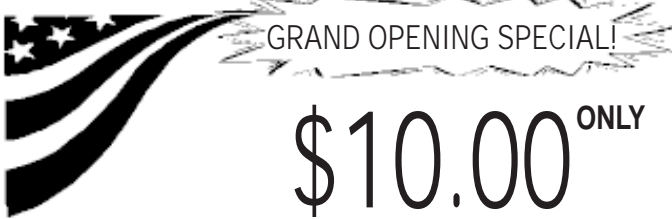
