

Kids' Craft

Stained Glass Window Craft

You will need: Elmers liquid glue, food coloring, a black permanent marker, a clear transparency sheet (or a clear, plastic report cover, cut in half), hole puncher, ribbon

- Before you begin, pour your glue in a few seperate cups. Add a few drops of food coloring to each and stir well. Make as many colors as you need.
- 2. On the clear plastic sheet, draw a simple picture to fill up the sheet. (an ornament, a snowman, holly leaves and berries)
- 3. Outline the picture with your black permanent marker.
- 4. With a paint brush, paint your picture with the colored glue on the BACK SIDE of your plastic sheet. (The side you didn't use your black marker on.) Make sure to rinse brush between each color.
- 5. Allow your picture to dry.
- 6. Punch a hole in the top of your clear plastic page. Then, string your ribbon through and tie to form a loop. You can hang this on a window, or do without the ribbon and hole punch and just lean it up against a window.
