Early History of Valentine's Day:

# Board Notes December 2004

The board of directors of Lakes on Eldridge Community Association met on December 20, 2004. The following is a summary of what was discussed.

The Board reviewed the financial statements for the period ending November 30, 2004. The Association had cash balances of \$42,821 in the Operating Fund and \$93,512 in the Replacement Fund. For the eleven months ended November 30, 2004 the Association had Total Income of \$791,739, Total Expenses of \$801,199 and an Operating Deficit in the amount of \$9,460. The financial statements were accepted.

For storage purposes, new shelves are being designed and considered for the clubhouse. The board reviewed the Beach Club reservation policies and draft revisions will be made in an effort to both clarify and better enforce policies.

Seasonal colors have been installed, and the diseased pear trees on Eldridge Parkway had been removed and replaced with crape myrtles.

The revised pool management contract was reviewed and approved. The board reviewed bids to repair vandalism damage to the clubhouse tower.

The managing agent reported that the North Harris County Regional Water Authority was increasing rates for pumpage from \$.34 to \$.59 per 1,000 gallons effective the second quarter of 2005.

The Board approved the renewal of the Association's insurance but requested the managing agent obtain an insurance appraisal to confirm whether the Association's property was properly valued.

Board meetings are generally held on the third Monday of the month at 6:30pm at the Beach Club. It is recommended that homeowners who wish to attend confirm the dates with AMI since they change occasionally. In addition, homeowners are welcome to bring business before the Board but are required to inform AMI of their intension to do so in order to be placed on the agenda.

February 24<sup>th</sup> – <u>Kite Runner</u> by Khaled Hosseini. An epic tale of fathers and sons, of friendship and betrayal, that takes us from the final days of Afghanistan's monarchy to the atrocities of the present. The unforgettable, heartbreaking story of the unlikely friendship between a



wealthy boy and the son of his father's servant, The Kite Runner is a beautifully crafted novel set in a country in the process of being destroyed. It is about the power of reading, the price of betrayal, and the possibility of redemption. And it is also about the power of fathers over sons -- their love, their sacrifices, their lies. The first Afghan novel to be written in English, *The Kite Runner* tells a sweeping story of family, love, and friendship against a backdrop of history that has not been told in fiction before, bringing to mind the large canvasses of the Russian writers of the nineteenth century. But just as it is old-fashioned in its narration, it is contemporary in its subject -- the devastating history of Afghanistan over the past thirty years.





Even a few seconds of closing your eyes and remembering the presence of love will make a big difference. At the end of your day, be with God before entering sleep. The formative minutes will build the consciousness that makes a productive life. \*

## **Lawn Maintenance Tips**


- 1) You can start any time and trim back your Crepe Myrtles, between now and end of February. It is best to trim back only what has grown this past year and lightly about no more than 18"inches to 2'ft. And no further, otherwise you lose that multi-trunk tree look. Make sure to remove any rubbing branches and unsightly weak branches and sucker growth. As far as fertilizing the best type is any fertilizer that you would use for Azaleas or Camellias will work just fine, etc.
- 2) During freezing weather make sure to use a cloth material for covering your plants instead of plastic material, plastic will freeze a plant quicker than conventional cloth. Also always water extremely well prior to any freeze, will also help keep plants from freezing, because the plants aren't under any type of stress, etc.
- 3) Just because it feels cool and there is no rain doesn't mean that your grass and shrubs are ok, they still need to be watered on a regular basis (unless it is raining), how often is usually 2-times per week and the time it will run would be cut in half or even less depending on location, saturation, and evaporation, etc.

4) Yes even though it is cold you can still plant just about any type of shrub and or tree this time of year. Planting now will help get the roots established and ready for hot summer heat, and not worry about plants suffering from heat, so it is an ideal time to plant.

## **Lawn Care Tip Of The Month**

If you are planting a groundcover under trees with a root system close to the surface, add about 15 centimeters of topsoil along with your 10 centimeters of organic matter. Then spread bone meal at a rate of two kilograms per 10 square meters to promote root development. Turn the bed to a depth of about 20 centimeters (the depth of a garden fork); mix thoroughly, then rake smooth.


