___How do I re-activate my pool ID from last year? Simply return the registration form with payment of \$10. per person (\$5. for ages 3-11) to: Steeplechase CIA, 11250 Steepleway Blvd. 77065 or drop off at the club during registration dates.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO ATTEND REGISTRATION.

What if I lost my ID from last year or never had one?_ You need to attend registration and obtain a new photo ID. If you cannot attend a scheduled registration session call

What are Pool Hours? Tuesday-Saturday: 10-30-8:30; Sunday: Noon-8pm

Why have an "Adult Swim"? This ten minute break is called to ensure that children take a rest period once an hour to prevent exhaustion and exposure, use the restroom (exclusive of the pool), put on sunscreen, get a drink and allow adults a short time to swim and enjoy the pool without the kids. It also provides a break for the lifeguards with usually just one remaining on duty.

What is the Bad Weather Policy? At the first sight of lightning or first sound of thunder the pool will be cleared. The pool will re-open 30 minutes after the last sight of lightning or sound of thunder.

Security

We just completed our Focus on Security at the May Open Residents Meeting - we had quite a few residents present, which was great! One of our Deputies was available to speak with residents about crime in the neighborhood. The good news is that he reports we are still in a very safe community. We don't have any really serious incidents, although as he noted any incident is serious if you are the victim. The biggest concerns are car burglaries and speeding. Deputy Fleming reminded us to keep vehicles locked and garages locked and closed.

We also discussed the recent graffiti painted on the fence, bridge and in the Saddlebough Playground - all of which has since been removed by the Association.

The sheriff talked about crime of opportunities - criminals don't want to work to steal - they are looking for easy targets. Remember lights deter, lock up everything, be alert and report suspicious activity. Report the hot spots for car speeding.

Thanks to the Sheriff's Department for hosting a 5-night Rape Aggression Defense Class at our clubhouse in May which was well attended (classes were full).

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COOL SUMMER SALADS

Fresh Broccoli Salad

bunch fresh broccoli
 green onions
 b. fresh mushrooms
 (2 oz.) jar pimentos
 green pepper
 tomatoe
 cucumber
 Salt & Pepper



- 1 (8 oz.) can water chestnuts (drained)
- 1 (8 oz.) bottle Zesty Italian salad dressing

Seven Layer Salad

Layer following vegetables in 8 x 10 dish in this order: 1 head lettuce, broken up 1 cup chopped celery 1 small can sliced water chestnuts, drained ¹/₂ C green onions, thinly chopped 1 box frozen English peas (do not cook) 1 pint real mayonnaise (spread over top) 6 oz. grated cheddar cheese

Cover and refrigerate 24 hours. Crumble 6 piece of fried bacon on top.

Chop vegetables. Add salt, pepper, and salad dressing. Chill 8 hours or overnight.
