COOL SUMMER SALADS

Fresh Broccoli Salad

1 bunch fresh broccoli
6 green onions
½ lb. fresh mushrooms
1 (2 oz.) jar pimentos
1 green pepper
1 tomatoe
1 cucumber
Salt & Pepper
1 (8 oz.) can water chestnuts (drained)
1 (8 oz.) bottle Zesty Italian salad dressing



Chop vegetables. Add salt, pepper, and salad dressing. Chill 8 hours or overnight.

Seven Layer Salad

Layer following vegetables in 8 x 10 dish in this order:

1 head lettuce, broken up
1 cup chopped celery
1 small can sliced water chestnuts, drained
½ C green onions, thinly chopped
1 box frozen English peas (do not cook)
1 pint real mayonnaise (spread over top)
6 oz. grated cheddar cheese

Cover and refrigerate 24 hours. Crumble 6 piece of fried bacon on top.

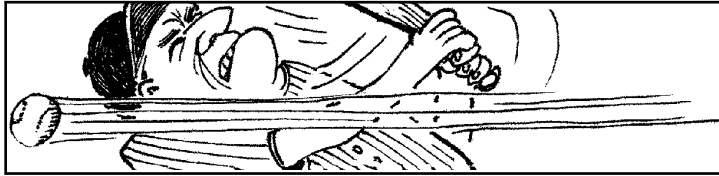
