#### **Annual Homeowners Meeting**

The annual homeowners' meeting was held November 9, 2005 at Kirk Elementary. There were approximately 67 homeowners present. The board president highlighted the accomplishments from 2005 and the goals for 2006.

Some of the accomplishments for 2005 included:

- · Cleaning and refurbishing the tennis courts
- · Replacing playground gravel with kiddy cushion mulch
- · Replacing & upgrading landscape lighting
- · Cleaning the Beach Club and gate house roof
- · Updating outdoor bathrooms
- Replacing Beach Club commodes
- · Painting and upgrading gates
- · Painting Summerland Ridge fence
- · Refurbishing decorative wall on Lake A
- · Updating the pool to be in compliance with new regulations
- · Painting and carpeting the Beach Club
- · Adding motion detector lights at the Beach Club and a gate in the clubhouse tower to reduce vandalism
- · Coordinating the creation of a storage room for the swim team
- · Irrigation repairs and enhancements, upgrading of irrigation controllers
- · Irrigation pump replacement (submersible pump also reduces noise)
- Upgrading several landscape beds and the adding of native plants
- · Reducing size and weight of Ginger Ponds entry gate and adding dual-motor to limit malfunctioning & repairs
- · Requiring all residents to have "LOE sticker" on car for easy resident identification
- · Asking residents to complete forms to identify regular maintenance staff
- · Implementing clear entrance admittance guidelines with gate attendants
- · Increasing cooperation with LOE North guards (checking gates at



#### ROAD SIGNS WITHIN LAKES ON ELDRIDGE

A Few Houstonians run red lights. A few Houstonians drive alone on the HOV lane. A few LOE residents run stop signs. A few LOE residents ignore LOE speed limits.

LOE stop signs and speed limits (25 MPH within LOE) are there for the safety of all. All drivers within LOE are required to obey

The Texas Highway Drivers Handbook states that a red stop sign with white letters means that YOU MUST BRING YOUR CAR TO A COMPLETE STOP. Slowing down is not enough. The same Handbook states that a Speed Limit sign indicates the maximum speed permitted on the roadway for daytime or nighttime.

Your Board of Directors has received several complaints that some drivers are ignoring the LOE stop signs and the speed limits. The Board considers that these are an important part of the safety environment we all strive for within LOE and it will take whatever steps it considers necessary to ensure that everyone driving within LOE complies with these requirements.





#### Help Keep Our Lights On

All residents of LOE pay a maintenance fee, a large part of which is spent on electricity to light our streets. The fee is billed to us whether the light is working or not. If you see a light(s) burned out, please help us by getting an address, or intersection, and the number on the pole. You should fill out the form available at www. centerpointenergy.com/outage.

You can call this information into CenterPoint at 713-923-3213, but the electronic form is much faster as you won't be put on "hold". You can also report dim lights, leaning poles, etc. on the form as

#### **Delivery and Service Vehicles**

Key Maps don't show the entrances on Tanner Road are gated. Because of this, delivery and service vehicles pull into these entrances and either can't or won't turn around. This leaves the next resident entering the neighborhood the choice going to another gate or letting in these vehicles.

To help control unregistered, and possibly unwanted vehicles in our community, when you are expecting a delivery or service (i.e. pest control) at your residence, tell the person you are speaking with that all entries are to be at the gate on Eldridge.

#### **Need To Post A Sign??**

Every now and then you need to get information to the community in a quick manner. You type up your sign and tape it to the gates. It usually rolls or folds back because it is not very secure. Then when

you are done, more than likely, there is tape residue left on the gate. Not a very pretty sight.

So here is a somewhat better solution. There will be black magnetic clips, and small poster board donated at the guardhouse. Type up your sign as usual, drop by the guardhouse, tape your sign to the poster board, and pick up 4 clips for each sign that needs to be posted. Use the clips at each corner of your sign and magnetically adhere to the gates. It's less messy, looks prettier and gives us a uniform style of posting information. When you are finished, please return all clips to the guardhouse.

If you need help typing up a sign, you can contact Michelle at 832-731-0943. If you would like to donate some clips or poster board, drop off at the guardhouse. (clips should be the black magnetic kind)



### 2,000 to change tomorrow, today, at this year's Heart Walk

Houston, TX – More than 2,000 area residents are turned out at Cy-Fair College on Saturday to bring awareness to heart health. On October 29<sup>th</sup>, local walkers participated in the American Heart Association's annual Heart Walk—taking a stand toward a healthier future.

The non-competitive, three-mile walk — which began at 8:00 a.m. with a warm-up by the Cy-Fair College Dancers — raised over \$175,000 to support heart disease and stroke research and educational programs in the Houston community. Teams were made up of employees of local companies, along with friends and family members of all ages. Participants who are heart disease or stroke survivors wore red caps that say "Fighting Back."

Walk Chairman, Terry Wheeler, CEO of Cypress Fairbanks Medical Center, pledged that Cypress Fairbanks Medical Center would make a total contribution of \$25,000 to the event through a combination of employee fund-raising and corporate sponsorship. Wheeler's employees embraced the lofty goal and far exceeded it, raising over \$20,000. Combined with a \$20,000 Presenting Sponsorship from the hospital and the Tenet Foundation, Wheeler was able to nearly double his pledge, giving a total contribution of \$45,000 to the walk efforts.

"Everyone knows someone affected by cardiovascular diseases like heart disease or stroke" said Wheeler. "That's why it's so important for all of us to participate in the Heart Walk and do our part to help save lives. It has been so gratifying to see everyone working together on a common cause and knowing that their efforts are helping to save lives in our community."

Dr. David Anthony, Superintendent of the Cy-Fair Independent School District challenged all Cy-Fair ISD employees to get involved in the Heart Walk this year and they enthusiastically accepted his challenge. Over 1,000 Cy-Fair ISD employees registered for the walk and they raised a combined total of over \$35,000. Clad in neon green t-shirts, the ISD walkers turned out in droves and cheered each other on as they each crossed the finish line of the 3-mile walk.

Diseases of the heart are the country's No. 1 cause of death; stroke is No. 3. Together these cardiovascular diseases kill more than 927,000 Americans each year and cost the nation almost \$400 billion in indirect and direct costs. The Heart Walk, a national American Heart Association event that will take place in more than 150 cities this year, has raised almost \$500 million for research and education in its 12-year history.


