We would like to take this opportunity to remind all that we cannot do it all by ourselves. As police officers, we rely upon the eyes and ears of the citizens as well. When you see or hear something that may be out of the ordinary and causes you to think that law enforcement should be contacted, then please do so. Let us respond and look into the matter. If nothing criminal is taking place, then we certainly have no interest in pursuing anything further. That vehicle you see parked at house that normally does not park there may mean that something is wrong. We ask that you close and lock your garage doors at night and at any other time when you will not be in a position to watch. It does not take long for a thief to walk into your garage empty handed and walk out with your property. When you park your vehicles, please do not leave any property in the vehicle that may bring the attention of a burglar. This would include purses, laptop computers, watches, wallets, etc... The car burglars walk from car to car at night looking inside each for something to take with them. You might want to take all garage door openers out of any vehicles that will be parked outside in the driveway. This will keep them from gaining access into the garage or interior of your residence. If your vehicle is unlocked it makes it that much easier for them. 




