Constable's Corner- By Deputy J. Blackledge

At the yearly Homeowner's Meeting in April, Sgt. Hazel and I spoke with several of those present about crime prevention and protection. We also spoke about the crime statistics for the subdivisions that encompass the Cypress Mill HOA, last year and this one, to date. I would like to talk again about some of these issues for those of you that did not attend the meeting.

With the rise in population and the presence of more businesses in the Cypress Area, there has been a climb in the crime rate. Last year, there were eight total residential burglaries in the area. As of March 31, 2006, there have been eight residential burglaries already and some car burglaries. There are several areas in which you can assist in the protection of your property. The most likely time for a burglary will be during the day while you are away. A commonly used tool in the burglar's arsenal is to simply knock on your door and see if anyone is home. At this same time, he/she can look inside your windows and see at a glance what type of property you have inside your home. It is a helpful tip to always answer your door if you are home. This lets them know that someone is there. If you notice that it is a solicitor or someone that you don't want to talk with, simply do not open the door, but ask them to leave. Try and shut your blinds during the daytime around exterior windows this will prevent someone from looking inside and seeing your property. At night, please make sure that you shut your garage doors. Also, lock your vehicles, taking care not to leave any items within. This will prevent car burglaries



from occurring. If you park a car in the driveway of your residence overnight, do not leave the garage door opener in that vehicle. This invites criminals to get into your vehicle and gives them access to your garage and residence at night. If you are home and see someone out of place on the street or at your neighbor's residence at any time of the day or night, please call our office to allow the deputies to respond and investigate the presence of the person/vehicle. Remember, if the person stealing from your neighbor today gets away, he/she will be back tomorrow to steal from you.

With the approach of the summer months, I notice that everyone has started taking care of their yards and flowerbeds. When you are out working in the yard, even during the weekend, try to keep your garage shut unless you are within eye sight. Most people keep high dollar lawn equipment and other items inside their garage; thieves will enter and take as much as they can carry while you are in the backyard mowing.

I ask that parents and other adults remember that there are no off road motorcycles, four-wheelers, or mini-bikes allowed on public roadways. I receive a large number of calls all through the year in regard to this one. In the past, a stern warning has sufficed and the violator usually does not repeat the offense. However, there has been a rise in these incidents, so citations may be issued to offenders.
