Dear Fellow Neighbors

Hi.

I'm a resident on Therrell. Late Saturday night, 3/25/06 at 9pm, a teen aged boy came through our neighborhood doing the direct marketing scam below. He sold his story as:

- he lived in Winchester, next to Cook school. I asked him for a street name, and he popped one off (if in Winchester, I wouldn't have known it).
- he mentioned a person's name, like "my mom, Mrs. Holt", and that she walks through the neighborhood with her dogs frequently.
- his efforts were purportedly to earn him enough points to travel to London, and that the money would be used to buy books for a children's hospital.
- he said paying him cash would enable him to double his points.
- he said his trip to London was part of a student exchange program.

In reviewing the receipt in detail after the transaction (yeah, I got sucked in), he's a contractor for the sales company, so is being paid for his efforts. There is clear reference to the fact that I will be receiving magazine(s) within 120 days. His presentation was silent on any sort of magazine delivery, but after a very cursory search on the net (using the company's address), they are involved in the marketing scam detailed in the attached links.

Ordinarily, I just say thanks but no thanks, but his story was well

read. He's obviously been coached in his delivery, content and tactics. It may be too late, as they likely canvassed the whole subdivision; but we can always be ready for next time.

Although I got sucked in, I've cancelled within the time alloted. I'll likely stop payment on the check I gave him.
