With summer here your kids will be spending more time at home, more time with friends, and more time on the internet. Today's youth is growing up in a computer age and they are spending more time online. This can be a good thing when they use it to research and learn about topics that interest them, keep a journal or web blog, create websites, play games, shop, and download music. Kids are quickly becoming computer experts and may even be more proficient than their parents, but they might not know how to avoid the dangers that can be found on the internet. This is where they still need your help:

As parents you can:

1. Tell your children about the risks on the Internet. Find out what they do online, what websites they visit, who they chat with and what games they play.
2. Keep the computer in an open area of the house where you can keep an eye on them.
3. Go online and look at the websites, chat rooms, and blogs that your children visit. This will help you identify what you think is important to discuss with them.
4. Remind them to never give out their name, address or phone number.
5. Never arrange a face-to-face meeting with someone they meet online.
6. Stay out of chat rooms unless parents say OK.
7. Never open e-mails from someone they don't know.
8. Let them know they can tell you if something doesn't feel right.
9. If your kids tell you that they saw something inappropriate online, don't blame or punish them; be happy they told you. Punishing them could change what your children share with you in the future.
10. Last, agree on rules of what they can and cannot do online, when they can go on the Internet, and how long they can stay.
