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Attention Residents With Homes For Sale In Village Creek

Please note that the Village Creek Deed Restrictions prohibit more than one Realtor, For Sale By Owner, Lease/Sale sign per home in our neighborhood. Lake Vista and other main streets are starting to look overwhelmed with realtor signs alerting prospects to homes for sale. If this is not addressed quickly our subdivision will become a clutter of advertisement mayhem.

Choice #1

<u>Deed Restriction, Article IX, Section 19</u> <u>Signs, Advertisements and Billboards.</u>

No sign, advertisement, billboard or advertising structure of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any portion of a Lot or Common Open Areas except for one sign for each Lot of not more than twenty-eight (28) inches by thirty-eight (38) inches solely advertising the Lot for sale or rent, and except signs used by Declarant or a Builder to advertise the Lot during the construction and sales period. The Declarant and the Association shall have the right to remove any signs, advertisements or billboard or structure which is placed on said Lot or Common Open Areas, in violation of this section and in so doing shall not be subject to any liability for trespass or other tort in connection therewith or arising from such removal.



Lost and Found Pets


Have you found someone's pet?
