2006 Annual Meeting Summary What you missed if you didn't attend.

The Lakes on Eldridge Annual Meeting of Homeowners was held Wednesday, November 8th at Kirk elementary. It was a good meeting. Attendance was the highest since before 2000.

Nikki Favero, Board President, reported that 2006 has been a busy and productive year. One of the biggest successes in terms of positive and long-term financial impact for the community has been achieving Tax-Exempt status for Lakes On Eldridge. Ms Favero reported that there had been many accomplishments during 2006 including: commissioning the community's first professional reserve study; replacement of the 550 Gallon Per Minute water well which supplies water for our various lakes and irrigation on the property; several major pump repairs or replacements, and a 90% reduction in costs associated with vandalism. The new Tax-Exempt status will generate savings for the community, which will help offset increased funding of the reserves to prepare for future major expenditures.

Ms. Favero reported that as a key principle, the Board focused on optimizing costs before increasing homeowner's dues. For example, this year, a new contract was negotiated with StarTex Energy at a savings of nearly 35% per kilowatt-hour. Since 2003 the relative changes in homeowner's dues have always been below the national inflation rate despite several cost increases that the Association had to absorb due to increased energy prices in the last few years. As recommended by the Reserve Study performed this year, the 2007 assessment was increased by 1.59% to provide for increased funding of the Reserve Replacement Fund.

The Treasurer's Report indicated that the community was in good financial standing, however, delinquencies had increased slightly since 2005. The Association is actively pursuing collection of those funds by means of a collection agency or litigation.

Two new Board Members were elected as Nikki Favero and Bob Adams' terms were expiring. Cory Hammond and Jerry Davis were elected to three-year terms. Cory currently serves on the Architectural Control Committee and Jerry Davis works with Bob Adams on the Gate & Crime Awareness Committee. The Board extends its thanks to Nikki and Bob for their leadership and service to Lakes on Eldridge. Nikki remains active as chair of the Landscape Committee as does Bob who chairs the Gate & Crime Awareness Committee.

Loss of a Cygnet

We lost a cygnet the morning of November 8th. He was located with his clutch mate on the small lake close to the entrance. He was found dead in the middle of the street at about 9:00 a.m. It just seems impossible a driver could have missed seeing him. This leaves a lone female.

The tragedy of the cygnet's death by automobile should cause all of us to ask how could this happen? If the driver was speeding, or careless, it could just as easily have been a child or an adult person.

Please, please everyone drive more safely. Please obey the 25-mile per hour speed limit and stop at all stop signs. Please report reckless drivers to AMI and/or the Sheriff's Dept. If you witness a commercial vehicle driving recklessly on our streets, please call AMI with the license number, date and time of day. A few rogue drivers can make LOE a dangerous place for our waterfowl...and our people.



Kids Look To Parents For Healthy, Active Holiday Season

The holiday season brings pumpkin pie and lots of turkey, but it should also include a healthy lesson for children, say nutritionists at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston.

Trying to create a new set of rules for holiday eating makes it hard to eat healthy, especially with the traditional once-a-year type of food that everyone enjoys.

"Help children create a healthy plate by mentally dividing the plate in half, one side for fruits and vegetables and the other side for protein and starchy foods," says Roberta Anding, instructor of pediatrics at BCM and a dietician at Texas Children's Hospital. "Hopefully, this is an everyday activity and as such sets the stage for the holidays."

Parents can also help by increasing the family's activity level. Engage children in holiday preparation by collecting pine cones for center pieces or playing a game of touch football rather than only watching it on TV.

Kids learn by example, which means parents should take an active role in their child's daily nutrition and not just during the holiday season, says Anding.

Alzheimer's Patients Benefit From Simple Holiday Strategies

A few simple strategies can help draw isolated Alzheimer's patients back into holiday gatherings.

"Too much holiday noise and activity can confuse patients with Alzheimer's disease, causing them to withdraw from surrounding social activity," said Dr. Mary Kenan, assistant professor of neurology and a psychologist with the Alzheimer's Disease Research Center at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston. "Disruption of routine for those with Alzheimer's can trigger behavioral symptoms, which makes caregiving more difficult."

To cut down on confusion, Kenan suggests asking family and friends to arrive at different times or visit in small groups.

"Patients with Alzheimer's disease can still enjoy the holidays," Kenan said. "Be sensitive to your loved one's strengths and limitations as well as to your own as a caregiver, and celebrate accordingly."

Empty Nest Chance To Chase Forgotten Dreams

Baylor College of Medicine

HOUSTON – Middle age woes are hard enough to deal with, but throw in empty nest syndrome and it is a recipe for potential depression.

Psychologists at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston say not to look at it as an ending, but as the beginning of a new stage in life with more time to travel, develop new hobbies, rediscover forgotten dreams and get to know your spouse all over again.

Empty nest syndrome can happen twice in an adult's life, once when the kids start kindergarten and again when they move out of the house. The more challenging of the two is when adolescents move out of the house to begin their adult lives.

"Parents have channeled all of their energy into their children for so long they may not know what to do with their time once they leave," says Dr. James Bray, associate professor of family and community medicine at BCM. "It is actually one of the high points when looking at the divorce rate scale. The numbers really tend to go up during middle age."

When people are unhappy in their marriage they usually have internal anxiety about something else, like not knowing what to do with the rest of their lives after the kids leave. "It is natural to reevaluate your life every so often and even more natural during this stage in a parent's life," says Bray. "Don't just assume that if you leave your spouse you will make the unhappiness go away. Marriage takes time and energy, so make the effort to get reacquainted."

It is a good idea to talk with friends to reevaluate goals and take note of some lifelong dreams you haven't had time to accomplish, says Bray.

Now that the kids have moved out, there may be more time to take dance classes, travel, exercise or go back to college to retool skills.

Kids need to remember to stand up for themselves if parents become too needy or clingy. Setting a phone schedule can eliminate the out-of-control calling by some parents, while reassuring them can eliminate needless worry.

"Kids can also consult with counselors if they really have an issue with a clingy parent or one that is having a difficult time dealing with the separation," says Bray.

The empty nest transition usually lasts six months to a year, depending on how well parents can adjust to their newly found freedom.



Holiday Sugar Plums


- 1 cup butter or margarine
- ½ cup confectioners' sugar
- 1 ½ tsp vanilla
- 2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/4 cup quick rolled oats (optional)
- ½ tsp. salt
- ½ cup finely chopped pecans
- 48 Maraschino cherries (about one 16-oz. jar)

Confectioners' sugar for finishing

Drain Maraschino cherries thoroughly on paper towels and set aside. Put butter and ½ cup confectioners' sugar in a large mixing bowl. Beat with an electric mixer on medium speed three to four minutes, or until well mixed. Stir in vanilla. Add flour, oats and salt; mix well. Stir in pecans.

Shape about 2 teaspoons dough around each cherry. Place on an ungreased cookie sheet about one inch apart. Bake in a preheated 350°F. oven for 12 to 15 minutes, or until set but not brown. Role in confectioners' sugar while still warm. Cool.

For a fun presentation, use cherries with stems. Remove stems, bake as directed and then insert stems in cookies while they are still warm but after rolling in sugar. Makes 4 dozen.






