IMPORTANCE OF REGISTRATION AT YOUR ONSITE OFFICE

All new homeowners, as well as current residents, are asked to register at the Legends Ranch onsite business office. This process ensures that all residents have access to the amenities such as the pool, automobile stickers, and EZ Tag enrollment (no cost with a Harris County EZ Tag) for entry into the EZ Tag gate entrance. Some electronic tag fees are applicable. Your proof of resident ownership will be needed to properly complete your registration.

The gate attendants will have a list of residents that have registered at the onsite business office. Your visitors should also be reminded to stop and register with the gate attendant. Association surveillance cameras are in place throughout strategic areas of the community.

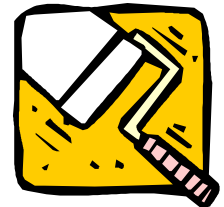

Legends Ranch Gate Attendant Services

The ISSC company provides our gate attendant service, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The gate attendant's office is located at the front entry to Legends Ranch.

As a reminder:

- The EZ Tag lane is for EZ Tag access only (Registration of Residents is required)
- Residents with a Legends Ranch vehicle sticker that do not have EZ Tags may enter through the covered drive lane nearest the building and stop to register with the attendant.
- Visitors must enter through the visitor land nearest the building and stop for the gate attendant's assistance.

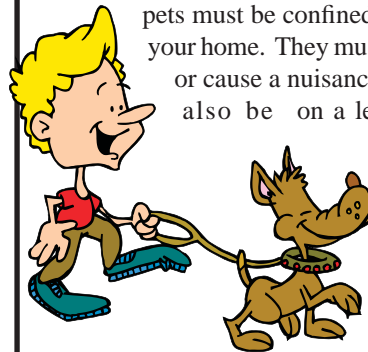


Planning on Outdoor Home Improvements?
