Board of Young Reporters by Trenton Telge





WHCMUD 11 Drainage Improvements for Willowbridge

by Glen Telge Homeowners on Parmer and Ballinger have noticed wooden stakes being placed in their yard and brightly colored markings sprayed on the street. Curious about what is going on, I contacted MUD 11 and spoke with their engineers at Carter & Burgess. They do indeed plan to conduct some major drainage improvement work on those streets in the coming months. This work will increase pipe and inlet size to address the stormwater ponding issues that were identified and discussed at the October 2004 MUD 11 Town Hall meeting with Costello, Inc, their drainage consultant. In several areas, the street will be torn-up for as much as a month. There is a plan to send out letters to the affected residents.

Also this spring, MUD 11 will be working to clean out the large stormwater detention pond located at the south end of Ballinger. Since it was determined a few years ago that this area is not a federally protected wetlands, MUD 11 will take steps to maintain it in a manner similar to the other, more visible, detention pond which is located on Wheatland across from Cook Middle School's practice field. We can all expect to see a lot of critters come out of those woods when the work begins in a few months, but it should really help the mosquito problem. The gate flap valve that was proposed to prevent bayou water from flowing backwards into our detention pond is still being evaluated by MUD 11 engineers. 
