Condition of the Retention Pond Walking Trails, Cypress Mill Park II

To The President of the Board:

This is a subject that has both angered and disappointed me. The area could be beautiful and useful. Instead, it is ugly and a health hazard. The water drainage paths are clogged causing standing water. This prevents mowing, creating a smelly breeding ground for mosquitoes. There are dead trees that haven't been replaced and more are dying because half of the sprinkler heads in the system are not working properly. The shrubbery is unkempt, some lying on the ground. The ditches along the sidewalk have standing water because they don't drain. As I walk the retention pond twice daily at a minimum, I can attest to the fact it is used by the community on a regular basis. Keeping it maintained only ads to the resident's pleasure, pride in their neighborhood, and resale values.

The MUD district collects half of the extra 1% sales tax charged in the shopping areas on 290. This includes Wal-Mart, Walgreens and Spec's stores. This is a lot of money you and I are contributing so why can't some of it be used to make this area more attractive? Ironically, all of the MUD district board members live in Cypress Mill Estates. Does the interest in our community stop at Cypress Rose hill or does it continue to all of the Cypress Mill community? I am proud of our neighborhood but I would like to see some improvements above a few benches that have been placed in the last couple of years.



Dental Tip of the Month.

Pregnancy and Dental Care?

Hello Friends,

Now that you are pregnant, so many exciting changes await your body.

Those changes can include changes in the mouth as well. If you have tender gums, or if the gums bleed when you are brushing then you have pregnancy gingivitis.

This is caused by plaque accumulating in the gums and on the teeth surfaces.

Usually if gingivitis is left untreated, it can cause irreversible gum disease called periodontitis. However, if the pregnancy gingivitis is left untreated, it can additionally cause complications with your pregnancy, such as premature childbirth.

The increased blood flow during pregnancy and the increased hormone production makes you more susceptible to gum disease.

I will recommend the prevention method. Brush twice a day for 3 minutes minimum. Be really gentle when brushing your teeth. Use a mouthwash twice a day, morning and night. Avoid eating too much sugar. However, if you have consumed a large amount, brush right after.

All pregnant women should receive at least two thorough dental cleanings during pregnancy. This will help prevent getting gingivitis during pregnancy.






