Dog Attack

On Sunday May 6th around 10:30 AM our Terrier was attacked in our front yard on Territory Lane by a Red Pit Bull. The Pit Bull along with a beige and black mix smaller dog was roaming the neighborhood. I heard the dogs fighting and ran to find the Pit Bull completely overpowering the small Terrier. I kicked the Pit Bull several times, but it never even acknowledged I was there. The Terrier finally got away and ran underneath my truck in the driveway. The Pit Bull was relentless and continued to pursue the Terrier. I was able to grab a lawn edger from the garage and hit the Pit Bull several times with that to finally make it stop the attack. The dogs continued north on Territory Lane.

I am happy to report after 3 surgeries and 10 trips to the vet, our dog is doing better and will be fine.

I am concerned for the people in our neighborhood, especially small children who may be playing in the front yard while parents are doing yard work or other tasks. Had this been an infant attacked instead of a Terrier, there is absolutely no doubt in my mind this would have resulted in a fatality. These dogs need to be found. 

WINCHESTER COUNTRY DOG PARK

DOG PARK RULES

This Dog Park is an off leash Dog Park and is maintained by WCMA and is for the private use for residents of Winchester Country only.

- 1. Dog owners/parents are responsible for picking up and disposing of all of their dogs waste.
- 2. Dog Park hours are 5:00 a.m. to dusk.
- 3. All dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the park.
- 4. All dogs must have current rabies and all vaccinations as required by the Harris County Public Health Department and should be healthy and free of contagious diseases and parasites.
- 5. Dogs must wear current license tags in the Dog Park.
- 6. Dog owners/parents must carry a copy of the dogs rabies vaccination certificate while in the Dog Park.
- 7. Never leave dogs unattended.
- 8. Dogs must be in view of and within voice control of their owner/parent at all times.
- 9. Dog owners/parents must carry a leash with them at all times while in the Dog Park.
- 10. Dogs in HEAT are prohibited.
- 11. Dogs showing any signs of aggression must be leashed and immediately removed from the park.
- 12. Dogs under 4 months of age are prohibited.
- 13. All dogs must be under the control of an adult.
- 14. No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades or any motorized vehicles.


