All new homeowners, as well as current residents, are asked to register at the Park Lakes onsite office located on the second floor of the SplashPad Texas building. This process ensures that all residents have access to the amenities such as the pool, automobile stickers, and EZ Tag enrollment (no cost with a Harris County EZ Tag) for entry into the EZ Tag lanes at the gated sections. Some electronic tag fees are applicable. Your proof of resident ownership will be needed to properly complete your registration.

The gate attendants maintain a list of residents that have registered at the onsite business office. Your visitors should also be reminded to stop and register with the gate attendant. Association's property is only under camera surveillance throughout the community's parks, gates, pools, etc.

CANYON GATE ATTENDANT SERVICES

Effective February 2, 2007 "ISSC" company began providing gate attendant services for the Park Lakes community. Hours of staffing are from 7pm to 7am, Monday through Friday, and 24-hour staffing is on Saturdays and Sundays. The gate attendant's office is located at the entry to Canyon Gate at Park Lakes.

As A Reminder

- The **EZ TAG LANE** is for EZ Tag access **ONLY** (Registration OF RESIDENTS is required).
- Residents with a Park Lakes vehicle sticker that do not have EZ Tags may enter through the covered drive lane nearest the building and stop TO REGISTER WITH THE ATTENDANT.
- Visitors must enter through the visitor lane nearest the building and stop for the gate attendant's assistance.



SplashPad Texas Cabana Rentals

SplashPad Texas has a private cabana that is available for party rentals by residents only. 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

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PLANNING ON OUTDOOR HOME IMPROVEMENTS?

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ROSES

How are your roses looking these days? Mr. Baxter Williams, past president of the Houston Rose Society recommendations for the hybrid tees:

- 1. Build a Bed: 12" above ground level, 1/3 top soil, 1/3 sand, 1/3 organic matter. Minimum 6 hours sun daily (morning sun/ evening shade preferable), Away from trees, shrubs and concrete since roses' roots won't compete with other plant roots and concrete radiates heat. Root system spread equates size of large garbage can. Plantings of 2 or more bushes, place 3 feet apart
- 2. Prune: February 14th

Remove 2/3 of total canes and anything smaller than a pencil

3. Insects:

Spider Mite: Little red specks size and color of paprika. They need to be on the plant to mate. Spray under side of leaves with a high power water spray every day for a week. After a week, the Spider Mite will die.

<u>Aphids</u>: Small green specks size of a flea, usually found around buds and young leaves. Spray them with a high power water spray. They will fly off to a more suitable environment.

4. Care: During the heat of the summer, each plant drinks approximately 5 gallons of water a week.

Fertilize once a month with slow release fertilizer - Start February 14th and continue through August. Without leaves your plant won't drink water.

Spray for fungus/black spot once a week; use Funginex (for control) and Mancozeb (to kill); mix into one gallon of water. Because one chemical is in powder form and the other is a liquid, you will need to shake the container frequently in order to spray evenly.

Spray, fertilize and water on schedule – not "as needed."

If you enjoy roses, but don't enjoy the above dedication, try one of the antique roses that are on the market today. After establishing the plant in its bed, their beauty involves minimal watering, occasional pruning, no spraying, and no fertilizing.
