# **Good News on Road Noise**

Sound Study Approval

Jersey Village Mayor contacts HCTRA on Road Noise

Thanks to all who have sent letters to Harris County Toll Road Authority (HCTRA) regarding the increasing road noise our community is experiencing from Beltway 8.

To recap, several residents of Willowbridge became concerned over the escalating noise from the Beltway 8 area. With the expansion will come increased noise from the traffic. Already noise has increased over the last year to the point it is affecting us being outdoors and enjoying the amenities of our community.

Our concern is that noise pollution adversely affects health, learning, and our home values. The homeowners of Westbridge, closest to the Beltway by McDonald's, have seen a reduction in the value of their homes over the past year. Our Homeowners Association is also concerned about the ever increasing noise and has sent in a letter supporting our request that something be done.

We discussed our concerns with the Deputy Director of HCTRA who has asked Harris County Commissioners Court (HCCC) for approval to negotiate a contract for a sound study to determine where and when the sound comes from. This has been approved. The two letters referenced are included in this newsletter.

In this situation sound is dynamic. That means it changes constantly with time of day, weather, wind, types and numbers of vehicles, and where you are in the landscape. A sound study will identify areas where noise originates – the first step. Then we will found out what kind of sound barriers, if any, would be most effective and where they should be placed. Now HCTRA is in contract negotiations with Kellogg, Brown, & Root. Then there will be a final contract approval by HCCC. It will be a long process, and we have taken the first step.

As always, a letter from you adds to the action. Should you be concerned, please consider a short letter to HCTRA. There is a sample letter included at the end of the article.

### **Jersey Village Concerned with Noise Pollution**

Unknown to me, residents in Jersey Village contacted their Mayor who recently approached HCTRA with their concerns over road noise from the Beltway. This is good because it adds additional weight to

our concern about the need to do something about the noise pollution from Beltway 8.

The Jersey Village people have started a fine webpage at www. freewebs.com/jerseyvillagenoise/index.htm. On it you will find upto-date reports on new developments in our quest to find peace and quiet again in our neighborhood, noise testing results, and a guest book where you can share your concerns. I will submit all articles and letter regarding the noise and HCTRA situation so you can view them soon. Former Willowbridge residents Mark and Dianne Maloy who now live in Jersey Village set this website up.
