Father and Son Prove Everything is Bigger in Texas

Keeping to an ageless tradition, Longwood residents Roger and Travis Ortmayer test their strength against the best in the country as well as the rest of the world while competing in Strongman competition. "The sport of Strongman incorporates tests of manhood from a variety of cultures around the world. The events are contrived of everything from ancient Scottish Highlander tests of manhood to mythological feats of strength by none other than Hercules himself," says the younger of the father/son team, Travis.

Travis is 26 and competes around the world professionally in Strongman, but don't think that since he is so young he is just a genetic freak quite yet. He has been training with weights since the age of 12; over half his life! Travis recently returned home from South Korea where he competed in his 3rd consecutive IFSA Strongman World Championship (which is televised on VS network). Also while in Korea, Travis won an international qualifying contest which was held just one day before the World Championships!

Roger, Travis' father, has also had recent success in Strongman. At nearly 61 years old he won his 2nd Master's National Championship which was held in MacPherson, KS. just this past September. Roger has been training with weights for the past 7 years and with some coaching from his son on the Strongman implements he has become one of the best Master's Strongmen on the planet.

This father/son team has now opened Athletic Nation Gym.. They did this because they believe that with their expertise in weight training and personal fitness they can make a difference in their society by helping men live longer and healthier so that they can enjoy their families as well as their favorite hobbies for the rest of their lives.

In addition to his duties at Athletic Nation, Travis is currently coaching our troops stationed at Ft. Hood for an Army Strongman (and woman) competition which is enthusiastically supported by the chain of command.

Roger and Travis have over 22 years of weight training experience and between them they have over 20 first place finishes in Strongman competitions; so you can believe they know what they are talking about and they practice what they preach!

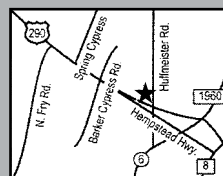

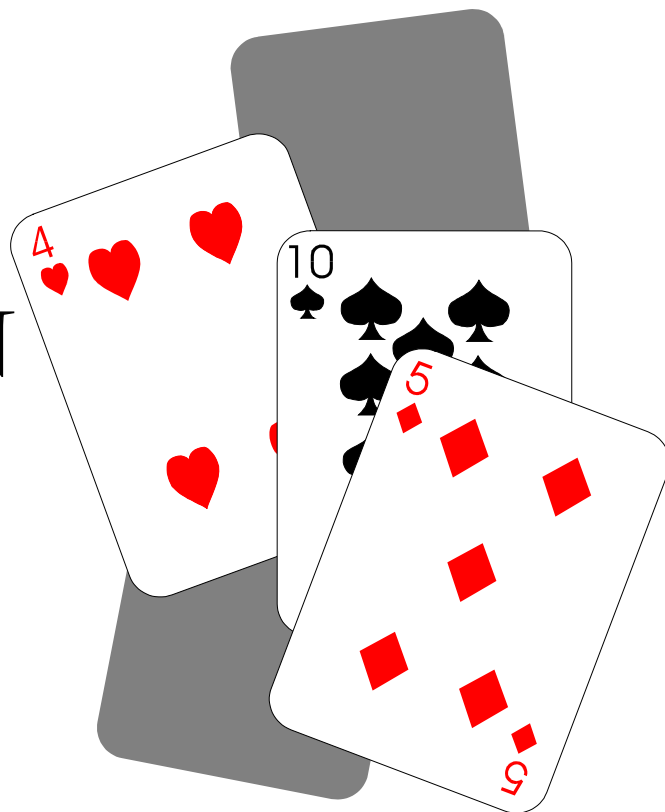

Set Your CLOCKS Back

Daylight Saving Time- Fall Back

On August 8, 2005, President George W. Bush signed the Energy Policy Act of 2005. This Act changed the time change dates for Daylight Saving Time in the U.S. Beginning in 2007. On the first Sunday in November, clocks are set back one hour at 2:00 a.m. local daylight time, which becomes 1:00 a.m. local standard time.

Many fire departments encourage people to change the batteries in their smoke detectors when they change their clocks because Daylight Saving Time provides a convenient reminder. A working smoke detector more than doubles a person's chances of surviving a home fire. More than 90 percent of homes in the United States have smoke detectors, but one-third is estimated to have dead or missing batteries.

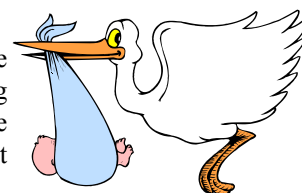

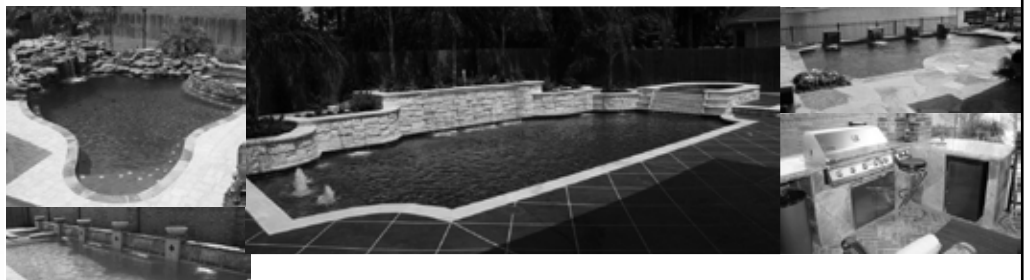
