If you have resolved, like many people do for the new year, to reduce stress in your life or become healthier, perhaps you've considered adding a yoga class to your repertoire. The problem you might encounter is how to find the right yoga teacher.

You may be looking for a private, group, or corporate yoga teacher. Austin has an abundance of teachers that are trained to teach in these various settings. There are many teachers that specialize and tailor their classes for certain groups of people such as runners, pre-natal, seniors, cancer patients and survivors, weight loss, and even regular every day people! The list goes on and on.

Trying out different classes, studios, and teachers is a great way to find the right teacher. When you attend a class, be sure to ask your instructor about their certification and what they do to continue their education. In Texas, yoga is a selfregulated industry. Many yoga teachers choose to join the Yoga Alliance (YA). Yoga Alliance registers both individual voga teachers and voga teacher training programs (schools) who have complied with minimum educational standards established by the organization. You will find 200- and 500-hour Registered Yoga Teachers (RYT) or 200- and 500-hour Experienced Registered Yoga Teachers (E-RYT).

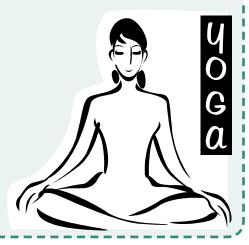
Choosing your teacher carefully can result in a rich and rewarding yoga experience. Some things to look for in vour teacher:

- Do they practice yoga themselves? How often? A dedicated teacher practices regularly, at least four times a week.
- How long have they been practicing yoga? At least three years of regular practice is important.
- With whom did they train and how long?
- Do they have specialized skills?
- Are they still studying yoga?

How do you find a yoga style that suits you? Try answering some of these questions:

- Do you want a vigorous practice that builds strength or would you prefer a gentle, restorative practice to help you relax?
- Is meditation or a spiritual focus important to you?
- How do you feel about practicing in a heated room?
- Are injuries, joint problems or other health conditions an issue?

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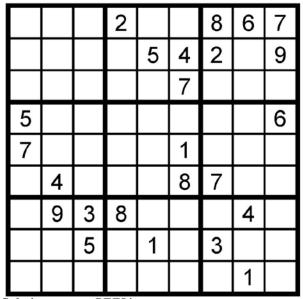
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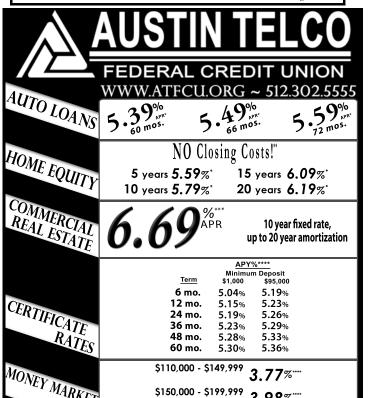
Sudoku
