The Riata Ranch HOA is excited to see our community participate in organized sports such as Cy-Fair Sports Association. We feel that these groups have the ability to unify communities while also giving our children the opportunity to learn important lessons such as teamwork, discipline, and respect for others.

Unfortunately, the Riata Ranch HOA has been forced to address an increasing number of complaints about the organized groups use of HOA property. Complaints have included, but are not limited to:

- Illegal street parking
- Littering
- Vandalism
- Disregarding posted rules
- Verbal assaults

The Riata Ranch HOA has repeatedly requested the violators to be considerate of our community, but these requests have been ignored. It is with this disregard of our requests that the Riata Ranch HOA is forced to restrict Riata Ranch parks usage to non-organized groups. A letter has been sent to the Cy-Fair Sports Association listing our grievances and stating our resolution that they are no longer welcome to use Riata Ranch community property to hold their events.


