RE: Steeplechase Pool Schedule for 2008 Swim Season

Your community pool opens 3:00 PM Saturday May 17, 2008 for weekends only. The pool will open for regular weekday activity effective May 30, 2008. Final swim days will be the last weekend in August & Labor Day (September 1st). The pool will be open when there is a lifeguard on duty. Hours of operation will be as follows:

The following qualifications must be met in order to use the pool facility:

1. Must have pool tag(s) at all times while at the pool.

Must be resident member and/or guest of a resident member.

3. Must be current on all Maintenance Fees to the (sub) Home Owners Associations.

All fees must be paid in full ten (10) days prior to receipt of tags.

4. Must comply with pool rules and policies

5. Pool tag not required for children two (2) years of age or younger.

For admission to the pool, 2008 pool tags will be required. The cost for pool tags are as follows: \$5.00 per family member; 2 Guests per house hold no charge. Tokens Still Accepted and Available \$2.00 (Old Pool IDS will NOT be accepted this year)

Cy-Fair Houston Chamber of Commerce's Partnership with Lone Star College – Cy-Fair A Success

Always on the lookout for innovative ways to help members and local business owners get one step ahead, the Cy-Fair Chamber of Commerce's Businesses In Growth (BIG) Academy has launched a program that offers a continuing education unit (CEU) for regular attendance at monthly meetings in 2008.

The BIG Academy's regularly scheduled monthly training sessions are on the fourth Tuesday of each month through October 2008. The sessions begin with a breakfast and networking session from 7:30 a.m. – 8:00 a.m., followed by an hour-long training/question & answer session from 8:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.

All training sessions will be held in the Cy-Fair Chamber's meeting room at 11050 FM 1960 West, Suite 100. Those who attend at least seven out of the ten training sessions will receive a BIG Academy certificate that announces the completion of the training, which is equal to one continuing education credit. CEUs are recognized as a measure of professional education and training, according to Lone Star College – Cy-Fair's web site (www.cy-faircollege.com).

"The whole idea behind the program, and BIG Academy, is to help businesses succeed and grow," said Melissa Rotholz, cochairman of the BIG Academy committee. "We pick topics that relate to businesses in our community."

Sessions will address sales and marketing strategies, goals, and planning for businesses.

She said the Chamber's partnership with Lone Star College – Cy-Fair has proven to be a successful strategy in and of itself in the BIG Academy's evolution. The Chamber is able to draw on the college's resources, and vice versa, in providing training, information and resources for Cy-Fair business owners who are involved in the committee's programs.

Recipe of the Month:



Picante Sauce

1 lb. peppers (bell, banana, & jalapeno; according to how hot you want the sauce; the seeds of the jalapeno peppers add a lot of WARMTH!)

3 onions 3/4 C sugar 3 qts. tomatoes 4-5 cloves garlic 1 C vinegar 2 T salt

Scald tomatoes and peel. Quarter and place in large pot. Chop peppers, onions, and garlic; and mix with tomatoes. Add sugar, vinegar and salt. Simmer slowly several hours until the sauce

is the desired consistency.


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Request for Home Improvement Approval


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Lone Star College
