President's Message Slow Down - See the Scenery!

While summer is not over for sure and the start of school is still to come, it's important to think safety especially on the streets and roads.

Living on one of the major thoroughfares of the neighborhood, I take time to watch the traffic on a frequent basis while allowing my children play outside. I tell you there are two types of people that drive through our neighborhood. 1) They are the 'fast as can be kind' and 2) The 'faster than I can believe kind'. Sure, there are few exceptions to this rule, but for the most part everyone is in a big hurry to get where they are going.

The Security Committee requests that each neighbor place one of the Windermere Lakes Palm stickers on each of their vehicles to help identify vehicles that clearly do not belong to residents in the neighborhood. Many of our neighbors have helped out in a big way and I can tell you it does make it easier to identify non-residents at the public docks, non-residents "parking" at the clubhouse and non-residents cruising the streets suspiciously and way too fast. I encourage each of you to place those stickers on your vehicles to help our officers quickly identify that the car parked in a driveway or street belongs in the neighborhood. Here is the ironic part of the sticker issue. Many times I've noted someone speeding through the neighborhood or blowing a stop sign while driving through the neighborhood with a Windermere Lakes sticker on the car. Many of the worst offender speeders actually live in our neighborhood! That is not a good thing!

Here is where each resident can help the overall neighborhood. I don't want to scold my neighbor anymore than anyone else. I mean, they know where I live! I sure don't need my neighbor riding me after a hard day of work, heavy traffic and lack of sleep. Maybe the resident isn't even aware they are speeding in the neighborhood. When you see your neighbor blasting home, you might ask, "Are you having a tough day?", "Is there anything I can do to help since it seems like you were in quite a hurry there?" If nothing else, it does show you care about your neighbors and you just might help them realize they may have been speeding around too fast! Let's hope that they might also ask the same questions of you when you really do need some help.

Finally, the next time you are riding or driving through the neighborhood, make a conscious effort to look down at your speedometer and say out loud how fast you're moving. Sure, the speed limit is 30, but why run as hard as you can? Ride through at 25mph or less. The scenery here in Windermere Lakes is pretty nice.

Dear Neighbors

We hear a lot in the news about "going green". Once a year there is "Earth Day" when we are all encouraged to recycle our electrical goods among other items.

Well, here in Windermere Lakes we all have the opportunity to recycle EVERY WEEK!!

The money you pay in your monthly water bill includes an amount for Waste Management to pick up certain items from your doorstep EVERY THURSDAY.

In order to get a green recycling box, simply call 713 686 6666 and ask for one to be delivered to your house. Once you have it you can place in it newspapers, magazines, cardboard from cereal boxes, most plastics including milk cartons and all cans both steel and aluminum. You'll find that this cuts down on your regular trash considerably......and you are "going green"!

Have you noticed that Kroger and Walmart are selling large re-usable cloth bags for \$1 each? They are really easy to use and much easier to carry into the house from the car! If you don't decide to use this option, then

remember that both Kroger and Walmart will re-cycle your plastic bags too.

Finally, clean water is an expensive item to produce and we all like to keep our lawns green using our sprinklers but when you see water running into the gutters and the drains, it's not helping your yard, it's just clean water down the drain! And it costs you money!

There is a subdivision in Sugarland that is about to get "gray water" to water their yards and clean their cars as they cannot get enough clean water…let's avoid that happening to us!!!

(Recreational Facilities Committee)



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
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Sodoku
