

#### The Green Corner Austin's Curbside Recycling Goes Greener

This month Austin's curbside recycling program goes greener. You may already be seeing the new 90 gallon recycling containers that resemble garbage cans. Better yet, you may already have one.

In October, the City of Austin is initiating its new single stream recycling program. Bins will be distributed beginning at the end of September and will continue through the end of year until all Austin residents have the new bins. The bins are larger; all recycled items can be thrown in the bin together without the need of binding cardboard and separating paper from glass, plastic, tin and aluminum. The only drawback I see at this time is the new recycling will be collected every other week rather than weekly but timing may not be an issue with the larger bins.

#### The benefits of single stream recycling:

1. More plastics can be recycled. The rules will be any rigid plastic from numbers 1-7. This includes those yogurt cups, margarine tubs, berry containers, and other similar items. This is an improvement over the current curbside recycling limitations to number 1 & 2 bottle shaped plastic containers. The downside is that it does not include all recyclable plastics such as the number 4 plastic bags that hold delivered newspapers or plastic grocery bags.

- 2. Pressed cardboard can now be recycled. This includes cereal boxes, soda boxes and other items that come in pressed cardboard boxes. Until now, pressed cardboard had to be carried downtown for recycling at Ecology Action and regular cardboard that could be recycled with City of Austin had to be cut into small pieces and bundled together. Now, all cardboard, including pressed, can be included in your recycling.
- 3. All items can be recycled together without separation or binding of specific items. Simply throw your plastic, glass, tin, aluminum and pressed cardboard containers into the bin with your newspapers and other paper destined to be recycled.

#### What cannot be recycled?

- 1. Soft plastics like plastic bags. But we can reduce those by carrying reusable bags to the grocery store. Also, HEB and Randall's both have plastic bag recycle bins available.
- 2. Egg cartons or other Styrofoam products
- 3. Take out containers.

## Sendera Chili Cook Off and Fair November 2, 2008

#### **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Official signed chili cook-off registration forms must be received by November 1, 2008. There will be no on-site registration the day of the cook-off. Judging is at 2:00PM. Cooks can begin set up at any time that day.
- 2. A chili entrant team may have no more than 4 people.
- 3. Chili must be cooked from scratch on site the day of the cook off. It must be prepared in the open at the entrant's booth site.
- Chili must be cooked using equipment provided by the cook: propane or gas stove or grill. There will be no electricity furnished and generators are not allowed.
- 5. A listing of ingredients used to make the chili must be displayed. Quantities do not need to be included.
- 6. Cooks are to prepare and cook chili in as sanitary a manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by the head judge. The cooked chili temperature must remain at a temperature of 140 degrees or higher at all times. All food, equipment, and utensils must be stored at least 6 inches off the floor on pallets, tables, or shelving at all times.
- 7. Appropriate "themed" decoration of your area and related costuming is encouraged!
- 8. Cooking will take place at the designated booth area only. Cooks must provide their own booth materials to include, table, chairs, cooking utensils, & ingredients.
- 9. Each team is responsible for preparing one pot of red or green chili (at least 3-5 quarts) to be judged. About beans- chili will be judged without beans, but teams may add beans before serving to the neighbors.
- 10. At the discretion of the head judge, cooks may be required to taste their own chili in front of a judge at any time during the event.
- 11. No deliberate sabotage to another contestant or their entry will be tolerated and such an act would lead to automatic disqualification. So, don't even think about it.
- 12. Firearms, explosives or other pyrotechnics will not be allowed on the premises. (Hey, it's Texas- we had to say it).
