

Winchester Country Pool Rules 2009

- 1. All rules apply to Adults and Children.
- 2. Only registered Winchester Country and Winchester Meadows residents and their guests will be allowed to use the pool. Maintenance fees must be current and pool registration must be on file in Guard office at the pool.
- 3. All residents must hold current pool cards in order to use the pool.
- 4. The telephone located in Guard's Office and Guard Check-in Station is for emergency use only.
- 5. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older).
- 6. The baby pool is restricted to non-swimming children who are under the age of 5.
- 7. Non-swimming children must stay in the baby pool and within arm's reach of an adult. This also goes for the large pool.
- 8. All non-potty trained children must wear swim diapers at all times provided by the Resident.
- 9. Parents or Guardian are responsible for children and/or guests in both the baby pool and large pool at all times.
- 10. Running is not allowed in the pool area. No horseplay will be tolerated either in or out of the water.
- 11. Glassware/glass containers are not allowed in the pool area. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area. Users of the

- pool are responsible to clean their area and use facility trashcans to discard their trash.
- 12. Abusive/offensive language or gestures, screaming, yelling or the playing of loud music or music with inappropriate lyrics will not be tolerated.
- 13. Smoking is not allowed in the fenced area of the pool facility. There are designated smoking areas in front of the Coordinator office and Clubhouse II.
- 14. Diving is allowed from the diving board only. No diving in the shallow end. Divers must jump straight out and not toward the sides
- 15. All persons younger than 18 years of age will leave the water during the scheduled hourly Lifeguard break / Adult swim period and sit away from the pool edge. Adults at least 18 years of age can swim at their own risk at this break time.
- 16. All swimmers must wear swim suits. No cutoffs are allowed.
- 17. Only Coast Guard approved floatation devices will be allowed and must be approved by the lifeguard staff.
- 18. Persons with bandages and/or open sores will not be allowed in the pool.
- 19. Cocoa butter, baby oil or other similar products will not be allowed in the pool. Commercial suntan preparations only.

- 20. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- 21. Gum chewing is not allowed in the water or pool area. All food is confined to the deck area only.
- 22. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen items or unclaimed items on the "Lost & Found" shelf. Unclaimed items will be disposed of throughout the pool season.
- 23. All non-swimmers must wear Coast guard approved floatation devices
- 24. Adult supervision is required at all times as relates to non-swimmers.
- 25. Only 2 non-swimmers per adult will be allowed.
- 26. All guests will be charged \$1 daily and may be issued a guest pass that must be returned upon leaving.
- 27. A resident must accompany all guests and is responsible for the guest's conduct.
- 28. No climbing on shade awning support poles or perimeter fencing.
- 29. Do not hold or hang on lane or diving-well ropes.
- 30. Do not talk to or distract lifeguards on duty.
- 31. All issues need to be reported to Senior Guard on duty.
- 32. The lifeguards on duty will have the final authority for the enforcement of pool rules and the overall safe operation of the

facility both explicit and implied by the Pool Rules and must be obeyed at all times.



Northwest Flyers Youth Track Club Information Session

Friday Evening, April 3rd, 2009

The Northwest Flyers Track Club will host a free open house / registration session for all middle and high school athletes and their parents interested in joining for the 2009 season. The event will be held on Friday, April 3, 2009, from 7:00 – 8:30 PM at the Champions Park subdivision clubhouse, 13635 Champions Park Drive**, Houston, TX 77069. The session will begin with a very important program overview / orientation at 7:00 PM. All interested athletes and parents should report on time.

The Northwest Flyers is a youth (ages 6 -18) track organization, affiliated with USA Track & Field. The club provides a full program of "track" events such as sprints, hurdles, middle distance, distance and relays, and "field" events such as long jump, triple jump, high jump, pole vault, discus, shot put and javelin. It is an excellent "offseason" program for young athletes who currently compete on their middle school or high school varsity track teams.

The club was founded 22 years ago by Olympic gold medalist Fred Newhouse to foster the development of youth track & field in the Northwest Houston area. Last year, the Northwest Flyers qualified 26 young athletes to compete at the U.S. Junior Olympics National Championships in Omaha, Nebraska.




