BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS

Remember, we do live in a big city. We have all the elements here and we have people looking to take advantage of people they perceive as victims. If a crime is going to occur, the offender must have three things to accomplish the task: desire, ability, and opportunity. Personally, there is not much that you can do about the offender's desire and ability. However, you can take steps to control the offender's opportunity.

- **BE AWARE** of your surroundings! Giving the appearance of not paying attention and not being alert is what offenders look for in a victim. Turn off your ipod/headphones or cell phone to reduce your risk of being a crime victim.
- You should never walk alone! However, if you must walk alone, have a plan and choose open well lighted and well traveled areas.
- When walking you should walk facing traffic. Do not read while walking or standing on the street. Be cautious of drivers that stop to talk to you or are not paying attention to the road.
- Avoid being on the street alone if you are upset or distracted.
- Always tell someone where you'll be and what time you are going to return.
- If you think you are being followed: cross the street, change directions, keep looking back so the person knows you can't be surprised. Look for a crowded area and move quickly.
- TRUST YOUR INSTINCTS: If something "feels wrong", something probably is wrong.
- If you find yourself in a situation with an assailant, don't be afraid to loudly call attention to what the assailant is doing ("Help!" "Fire!" "Get your hands off me!" "This stranger is bothering me...", etc.).
- Report suspicious persons to the police immediately!
- Keep emergency numbers near your phone.
- Do not leave messages on your door, or voice mail, etc., indicating you are away or when you will return.
- Be cautious of telephone surveys and NEVER... give out any personal information.
- Do not prop open doors or gates. This will put everyone at risk.
- Always LOCK your doors, garage and windows.
- Keep access cards, keys and remotes in a safe place. Do not leave them lying out in the open. Never leave them on a table or shelf near your door. It takes less than 10 seconds to look into your open door and steal items from a table or shelf near the door.

CLUBHOUSE POOL


The Clubhouse pool will be open on a trial basis October 10, 2009 thru May 1, 2010 from 5:00AM-10:00AM. Access will be limited to residents over the age of 18 for aquatic exercise & lap swimming only. No lifeguards will be on duty and it is SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. If all rules and regulations are not adhered to, this privilege may be suspended at any time. In order to use the pool during the swim at your own risk hours, you must review, complete and submit a legal waiver. The legal waiver can be found on the intranet at www.canyongate.com/residents/lr or at the Clubhouse office. All signed legal waivers must be submitted to onsite staff in order to gain access by handscan to the pool. Access will be available by handscan only to limit access (access cards will not be activated during this time frame). The Gate Attendant will be monitoring cameras at all times and has orders to call the constable if any behavior that is considered inappropriate is observed. All pool gates must be closed securely at all times and upon entering or exiting the pool area. The Clubhouse restrooms will not be available during these hours.

<u>SPLASHPAD</u>

"PAD" AT SPLASHPAD will be open weather permitting during onsite office hours only. For more information on SplashPad hours, please call 281-681-9750. The SplashPad pool is closed until May 2010.

SplashPad POOL is CLOSED.




Living Legends New Legends Ranch Seniors Group

Update on Stop Light at front of Legends Ranch Community


A traffic survey has been completed by the county and a light has been approved for placement at the front of the community, by Precinct 3 of the county commissioner's office. The design engineer has almost completed the design plans for the intersection.

Legends Ranch is 7th in line behind other local intersections being addressed. Due to our place on the list and the time it takes to have the funding certified, the installation may not be completed for another year to year and a half.
