ASK THE COACH

Dear Coach,

I have been walking every day for the past six months. After losing 10 pounds in the first 2 months, I have not lost any since! I am frustrated by my lack of results, what can I do?

Sign Me Frustrated

Dear Frustrated,

You have learned firsthand about 2 common training concepts: training effect and training plateau. "Training effect" is the usually positive effect that your body will get from the first 8 weeks in a new program. Once those first few pounds melt away, the body adjusts and then plateaus where you stop seeing results.

The best program is one that continually challenges the body. If you enjoy walking, change up the tempo or the incline (even try walking backwards!). Also, put in a couple of days with weights/bands/jump rope/etc at the house or in the gym in order to challenge your body and jump-start your metabolism again. If you still are not seeing desired results, you should ask a trainer or a nutritionist to look deeper into your eating and exercise habits.


