
THEFTS AND VEHICLE BREAK-INS

Lakes on Eldridge is a safe and pleasant place to live, but a theft was recently reported. Here are important suggestions to prevent this from happening to you:

2. If you can provide exterior lighting to your home, do so. Thieves work in shadows, so the fewer the shadows, the less safe haven they have in which to work.

- 4. ALWAYS lock your car.
- 5. If you see or hear anything suspicious, call the police first and then the gate attendant.



COMMUNITY RULES REMINDER NOVEMBER 2009

A recent incident of apparent vandalism prompts a reminder this month concerning the **tennis courts:**

- A. Only Lakes on Eldridge residents and their guests are permitted to use the tennis courts
- B. No use or activity except tennis is permitted on the courts.
- C. Non-playing children are strictly prohibited from courts during play.
- D. Tennis shoes must be worn on the courts.
- E. No bicycles, skateboards or roller blades are permitted on the courts.
- F. Players are required to observe tennis courtesies, as well as rules of good conduct on and around the courts.




LOE BOOK CLUB





