NEW CELL PHONE LAW

"I'll Have to Call You Back; I'm in a School Zone."

THE LAST SESSION OF THE TEXAS LEGISLATURE PASSED A NEW LAW MAKING IT ILLEGAL TO USE YOUR CELL PHONE IN A SCHOOL ZONE. THE EXCEPTIONS ARE:

- if you are using a hands free device
- if your vehicle is stopped
- if you are calling 911 for an emergency.

The law took effect September 1, 2009. Soon you can expect to see new signage in school zones reminding drivers to hang up or face a fine of up to \$200.



SENATOR DAN PATRICK SPEAKS


At Pack 1537 Meeting

Splinters from the Board

At our annual homeowners meeting in October many questions were raised about stop signs in Wortham. We asked our management company to assist us in getting answers and below is the letter we received from our manager at Crest Management for your review:

"Dear Board members,

I had a long conversation with Paul Hawkins at Commissioner Raddack's office regarding the locations below and the process in which the traffic studies are conducted.

- Azalea Creek and Wilderness Hills: All three intersections on Azalea Creek received a traffic study in October 2008. Because so many requests were received at this particular location and because a traffic study had been conducted prior to 2008; Commissioner Raddack's office hired a third party consulting firm to review the traffic study that was conducted in October 2008. The outside consultant reviewed the results from the study and indicated that the traffic volume was not great enough to warrant a multi way stop.
- Eldridge and Wortham Ridge and Eldridge and Hastings Green: A traffic study was done in 2008 for these locations as well. The update for this intersection is the same as above.

• Walnut Lake and Dogwood Blossom: A traffic study was done in 2004. He believes that he can now get approval for another traffic study at this location since one has not been done in approximately five years.

I emailed Mr. Hawkins all of the information that we have on the above intersections and let him know that this is a topic of concern at every annual meeting that we have. He is going to look into what we can do now and will respond accordingly in writing. Once we receive the response in writing, it may be a good idea to post the information on the website. We can also post Mr. Hawkins contact information on the site so that homeowners with questions and concerns can get a response directly from the source".

The hike / bike trail modification is now complete. Due to a drainage issue the ADA modification had to be broken out and replaced and it looks good.

As still another reminder we are in need of a community neighborhood watch chair! Please contact any of our board members if you have an interest and let's not wait for something to happen and wonder why we didn't have this coordinated the way it should be done.




