

SILENT KILLER CAN BE PREVENTED WITH TEST

A stroke is called "the silent killer" because patients don't feel the symptoms leading up to it. This is national stroke awareness month and some in the medical field are trying to get the word out that stroke can be prevented with a simple screening.

63-year-old Glenda Newton says she's always been in good health.

"I've not had high cholesterol, my blood pressure has always been below normal, i'm not overweight, i don't have diabetes," she said.

So last year, when she convinced her husband they should get screened for stroke, she was shocked by what she was told.

"'You're in imminent danger of having a stroke any minute' and I went, 'really?' took me back because I expected George to have a problem, but I've never had any health problems.

An ultrasound machine found that about 90 percent of Glenda's carotid artery was blocked. Her doctor told her she had a 25 percent chance of having a stroke any minute.

So she had surgery to clear out the blockage from her artery. Now



the only sign that she was once at risk of stroke: a faint scar on her neck.

"I've Never had a symptom so it was a great shock to me to go through this at all," she said.


Glenda says she may owe her life to the screening she got from "Health Yes," a mobile medical screening

provider. During the screenings, technicians check blood pressure, cholesterol and the carotid arteries.

The stroke is more or less like a heart attack in the brain. There are two types of stroke and one is when an artery is clogged by plaque and that can happen when people have high cholesterol over many years. The other is when an artery in the brain ruptures.

The symptoms that predispose patients to stroke are things which they don't feel. They're things that go on in bodies for years and then suddenly show up and when they do it can be devastating.


Screenings can cost up to two-thousand dollars at a hospital but "Health Yes" is offering the screenings through the end of may for less than 200 dollars.




- GOOGLE HEALTH Store your family's medical records securely online, making it easy to share with your doctor or other physician when necessary
