STEEPLECHASE RECOMMENDS THE MERGER

Of All Associations Into A Single Association

WHAT DOES A MERGER OF THE ASSOCIATIONS MEAN?

The Boards of Directors for Churchill, Cobblestone, and Greenbrook Bridge have voted to merge these three Associations into the Steeplechase Community Improvement Association subject to the approval of the membership of each Association.

With such approvals, there will be a single Association and single Board of Directors responsible for the operation of the Steeplechase community instead of the four Associations as is the current situation.

WHY SHOULD THIS BE APPROVED?

To simplify and streamline the management of, and the planning for the Steeplechase community

- Reduce the number of accounting audits and tax filings
- Eliminate duplicate insurance policies
- Produce a single set of accounting statements instead of four thereby significantly reducing accounting time
- Simplify banking accounting and reconciliation

HOW DO WE DO THIS?

Each Association will have its Special Election for approval of the merger and election of a new Board of Directors for the Steeplechase Community Improvement Association. The merger is planned to be effective January 1, 2011.

Newsletter and website articles will start appearing in the March issues giving further information about the proposed Merger, dates of these Special Elections and other appropriate details. If you have questions, please raise them with any Board member.



AVOID ID THEFT

During The 2010 Census

THE CENSUS will be mailed to 134 million households on March 1.

The form has 10 questions about your age, date of birth, race and whether you rent or own a home.

It does NOT ask for your social security number or information about your taxes and income.

If you do not return a completed Census Form by April 1, it is likely that a Census Taker will either call you or come to your door to obtain the information.

BE CAUTIOUS AND USE THE FOLLOWING SAFETY TIPS:

- 1. The Census does not ask for your Social Security Number - do not give that information out to anyone claiming to be with the Census Bureau.
- 2. Never invite a Census Taker into your home.
- 3. All Census Takers carry official government badges marked with just their name, a Department of Commerce watermark, and an expiration date.
- 4. The Census Worker is supposed to provide you with a letter from the Census Director on official letterhead.
- 5. The Census Bureau will not contact you via email.
- 6. Do not click on any websites that pop up disguised as a census survey. The Census Bureau does not solicit information over the internet.
- 7. The Census does not ask for credit card or bank account information.

ASK YOURSELF:

- If Sheriff, Ambulance or Fire Department were dispatched to your home right now, could they easily find it?
- Is your house number clearly visible on the curb in front of your home?
- Is your house number clearly visible on the front of your home?
- Is your porch light left on at night?
- Are all streetlights near your home operational?

Answering "No" to any of these questions means valuable minutes are lost trying to find your location - verses helping you. When time is of the essence, safety is on the line; do you want emergency response to waste precious time trying to find your home?

If navigating someplace new, you usually use directions, look-up the location on the internet, have identifying clues such as type of car in the driveway, balloon on mailbox, turn left at the Valero. When emergency services are dispatched to your location, in most cases this is the drivers first time to your location, they have limited time available to get there and identifiers such as a visible house number are essential in reducing response time.

In driving around Steeplechase, I am dismayed at the number of homes that are dark and lack an easily visible house number. I'm not sure how you think any of the emergency response teams can find you, but I assure you, it will take them much longer than necessary.

I urge each resident to take a moment and take a look at your home at night. If you can't easily and quickly see your house number on the front of your home and curb, please rectify. If your streetlight is out, report it. And, leave your porch light on at night.

Emergencies happen. You need to be prepared, so does your



Northwest Flyers Youth Track Club Information Session


Monday Evening, April 12th, 2010

The Northwest Flyers Track Club will host a free open house / registration session for all middle and high school athletes and their parents interested in joining for the 2010 season. The event will be held on Monday, April 12, 2010 from 7:00-8:30 PM in the Cypress Room at the Methodist Willowbrook Hospital, 18220 Tomball Parkway, Houston, at the corner of FM 1960 and Highway 249. The session will begin with a very important program overview / orientation at 7:00 PM. All interested athletes and parents should report on time.

The Northwest Flyers is a youth (ages 6-18) track organization, affiliated with USA Track & Field. The club provides a full program of "track" events such as sprints, hurdles, middle distance, distance and relays, and "field" events such as long jump, triple jump, high jump, pole vault, discus, shot put and javelin. It is an excellent "off-season" program for young athletes who currently compete on their middle school or high school varsity track teams.

The club was founded 23 years ago by Olympic gold medalist Fred Newhouse to foster the development of youth track & field in the Northwest Houston area. Last year, the Northwest Flyers qualified 42 young athletes to compete at the U.S. Junior Olympics National Championships in Greensboro, NC.
