REMINDER OF LOE

Parking Regulations

The following parking regulations are defined in the LOE covenants and were designed to promote safe and "neighbor-friendly" parking practices. A complete copy of the Street Parking Resolution can be found in the resident website.

The Lakes on Eldridge deed restrictions limit parking on the street to no more than 14 days in any 30 day period. **THE STREET PARKING RESOLUTION ADOPTED IN 2002 FURTHER STATES THAT:**

- 1. ON-STREET PARKING OF VEHICLES IS DISCOURAGED EXCEPT FOR SHORT PERIODS OF TIME.
- 2.NO VEHICLE SHALL BE PARKED AT ANY TIME SO AS TO:
 - a. Inhibit the free flow of traffic, including emergency vehicles
 - b. Create a safety hazard
 - c. Block access to driveways, fire hydrants, mailboxes, etc.
 - d. Block a clear view of any intersection
 - e. Be parked directly across the street from a driveway.
- 3. COMMERCIAL VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED IN AN ENCLOSED GARAGE AT ALL TIMES.
- 4.VEHICLES THAT ARE NOT PROPERLY LICENSED, REGISTERED, AND INSPECTED MAY NOT BE OPERATED ON LAKES ON ELDRIDGE
- 5. REMEDIES OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR VIOLATIONS INCLUDE:
 - a. Legal action to restrain the violation or to recover damages, including reimbursement of attorney's fees and costs.
 - b. Towing at the vehicle's owner's expense.
 - c. Levy of fines





It's springtime again, and you can expect to see some new arrivals of cygnets on our lakes. Mother Nature provides our LOE swans with some common sense. At this time of year they feel the need to protect their territory against predators including humans, dogs, and waterfowl. Our cobs (males) will become aggressive and territorial in trying to protect their pens (female) and nest. This is usually temporary until mating season is over. If you are walking past a lake and a swan swims to your side and follows you, BEWARE! If you see a swan with his neck back and feathers up please stay away! Do not attempt to feed him, and walk on the other side of the street as he is in his ATTACK position. Please warn your nannies and sitters not to stroll babies around the swans. Please remember that the swans are merely protecting their territory and readying the area for their young. We need to be as cautious of them as they are of us. Thank you for your cooperation!

SWIMMING POOL PRESEASON NEWS

To help ensure that your visit to the pool is a safe one, we are excited to announce the addition of the lifejacket loaner program, which we offer at our own expense, since we feel so strongly about it. We will provide a station at the pool containing lifejackets in a range of sizes, available for all community members to check out and use during your visit. While using a lifejacket should not replace learning to swim, we feel that this program will aid when necessary in the transition into a more water safe individual.


<u>LET US START THE SWIM SEASON ON A POSITIVE NOTE</u> WITH THESE VALUABLE SAFETY REMINDERS:

- Parents must closely supervise their children at all times.
 Remember, it only takes seconds for a child to drown.
- Do not dive in areas marked "NO DIVING". Nearly 90 percent of all spinal injuries occur in the shallow end of the pool.
- Breath holding games can be very dangerous and may cause cardiac arrhythmia or seizures. Games like who can hold their breath the longest and swimming the longest distance underwater should be avoided at all times.
- Don't allow children to play with or around the main drain. The main drain suction can be very powerful and has been known to cause severe injuries and in some cases death.
- The safety of a child in the baby pool is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. The lifeguards will always enforce the pool rules throughout the facility, but children who cannot swim

- must have an adult within arms reach at all times. The same rule applies even if the child is wearing a floatation device.
- Define a safe zone for your children where they can always touch the bottom. One of the most common saves a lifeguard must make is when a swimmer strays to an area that is too deep for them to stand.
- Access rules to the facility will be strongly enforced and are
 the responsibility of each member to understand and follow.
 It is a very awkward and uncomfortable situation for everyone
 when a lifeguard must ask a member to go back home to get
 the appropriate access tag.
- Remember that there are several different types of people who
 like to use the pool throughout the summer. Both young and
 old, everyone wants to have a good time.
- If you should ever have a question about the pool rules, ask a lifeguard or manager. It is better to be safe then sorry!
- Help educate your community members and their guests on water safety. A team approach towards safety will offer a safer swimming environment.

Remember that ultimately you, as the parent/guardian, are the first line of defense for a safe trip to the swimming pool. Always keep your non-swimming or newly swimming children within arm's length.

With your support, we are confident that the 2010 swim season will be a safe and positive experience for all.





DOYOU LIKE FREE SOFTWARE?

Hey, everybody likes free software – just be careful what you get. Enter anything you want into a Google search with the word FREE and all kinds of things will show up. If you're not careful, you can download a FREE VIRUS – how's that for a deal?

For you readers, here are a few of my favorite free software choices that won't get you into trouble:

For Windows machines, I like Picasa for doing simple editing and cleanup of

photos. It's from the folks at Google and you can find it just by going to www.Picasa.com (note that it's Picasa ending with an "a" and not Picasso like the painter with the additional "s"". Do you shop online and like to keep the receipts? Rather than printing them out and storing them in a filing cabinet, use CutePDF to "print" your receipts (or anything else that can be sent to a printer) into a PDF file that you can save on your hard drive. I buy a lot online and CutePDF lets me store all the receipts into a folder on my hard drive that makes life much easier at tax time for my accountant (which is this month if my calendar is correct.) You can download CutePDF at www.CutePDE.com, just download the CutePDF Writer. It installs as if it were a printer and you're ready to go.

For the Mac, Anxiety is a useful to-do list manager to (hopefully) reduce the stress in your life in getting all the things you need to get done, done. It works with iCal and Mail. You can download



it at http://www.anxietyapp.com/. Carbon Copy Cloner lets you backup your entire hard drive to another, allowing you to boot to the 2nd drive should the first one fail completely (and it happens more often than you know.) Download it at http://www.bombich.com/.

Stay away from sites offering free music or movies (like LimeWire), this is an excellent way to contract a virus. If you think you're getting something

that costs money in a store for free online, it's probably going to cost you more than you know by the time you get your computer cleaned up.

Be skeptical and be safe. One of the best places to go for free software is http://sourceforge.net/. You're not going to find Microsoft Office for free, but you might find a program that does something close. Want Photoshop but don't have \$400 to spend, then check out Gimp. There are a lot of genuinely nice people developing programs because they enjoy doing it. Some will ask for but not require a donation, that's only fair. If you like a program, throw a few dollars their way to encourage them to keep improving their program. If you can say "I wish I had a program that", then you'll probably find something at SourceForge. net that meets your needs. **- Submitted by Laurie Scott**

It's Tax Refund Season again. This year, if you're going to get a check from your Uncle Sam, why not put it to work to help you meet your financial goals?

Last year, the average tax refund was more than \$2,700, according to the IRS. The size of your refund, or whether you will get one at all, depends on your individual circumstances. But if you are going to get a refund, plan ahead for what you'll do with it. Here are a few possibilities:

- **PAY DOWN SOME DEBTS**. In these difficult economic times, you may be carrying a higher debt load than usual. If so, you may want to use some of your refund to pay down some of these debts. The lower your debt payments, the better your cash flow and the more money you'll have to invest for the future.
- BUILD AN EMERGENCY FUND. If you don't already have an emergency fund containing six to 12 months' worth of living expenses, you could use your tax refund to start one. Without such a fund, you may find yourself constantly dipping into your long-term investments to pay for unexpected costs, such as a new furnace or an expensive car repair. Keep your emergency fund in

a liquid account — one that you don't draw on for your day-to-day expenses.

• **HELP FUNDYOUR IRA.** In 2010, you can put in up to \$5,000 to your IRA. Consequently, if you received a \$2,700 refund, you'd have more than half of what you need to fully fund your IRA for the year. (If you're 50 or older, however, you can contribute up to \$6,000 per year.)

You might not think that your \$2,700 would make much of a difference in the long run. But by investing your refund and giving it many years of growth potential, you could end up with a sizable amount. Consider the following:

- If you put \$2,700 in your IRA, and you earned, on average, seven percent a year for 30 years, you'd end up with about \$20,000, even if you never invested another dime.
- If you put \$2,700 every year in that same IRA, again earning an average seven percent annual return, you'd end up with more than \$270,000 after thirty years.



(These examples are hypothetical illustrations and do not represent any currently available investments.)

You'd eventually have to pay taxes on your earnings, typically when you make withdrawals at retirement. And if you qualified for a Roth IRA, you'd never have to pay taxes on your earnings, as long as you had your account for at least five years and didn't start taking withdrawals until you were at least 59-1/2.

• CONTRIBUTE TO A SECTION 529 PLAN. If you have children or grandchildren, you may want to establish Section 529 plans to help them pay for college. You can contribute virtually any amount, and the earnings grow tax-free, provided the money is used for higher education expenses. (Withdrawals used for expenses other than qualified education expenses may be subject to federal, state and penalty taxes. Contributions are tax-deductible in certain states for residents who participate in their own state's plan. Please note that a 529 college savings plan could impact a beneficiary's ability to qualify for financial aid.)

You may be tempted to spend your tax refund on things you want today — but, with a little planning, you can use it for things you need tomorrow.

Do you have a favorite playground? Maybe it's a new wooden one that has lots of tall towers and passageways. Or maybe your favorite is an old-fashioned playground with swings and a seesaw. Playgrounds are fun places for kids because there's so much to do and other kids to have fun with. But sometimes kids get hurt at playgrounds. That's no fun, so here are 10 ways to keep safe:

I. Take a grown-up. As kids get bigger, they like doing things on their own. Going to the playground shouldn't be one of them, though. Grown-ups come in handy because they might spot problems at the playground, they can help you down if you get in a tight spot, and they can help if you happen to get hurt.

- **2. Take a good look around.** If the playground has lots of trash, such as broken glass, or the equipment looks broken, don't play there.
- 3. Keep your size in mind. Many playgrounds have some equipment that's for little kids (like 2- to 5-year-olds) and other equipment that's meant for older kids. Use the equipment that's right for your age. If you squeeze yourself onto a swing for toddlers, you might get stuck. Likewise, if your little brother or sister starts climbing something meant for older kids, guide him or her to the little kid stuff.
- 4. Don't go too high. Many playgrounds have tall stuff to play on, such as towers or open passageways between equipment. Don't climb higher than you feel comfortable, and feel free to ask your grown-up if you need help getting down. Never climb up the outside of equipment, or hoist yourself up on the roof. The view might be cool, but it's a long way down.
- **5. Look out below.** The best playgrounds put down special surfacing material, such as mulch, wood chips, sand, gravel, or rubber matting. These surfaces can help soften a fall, but that doesn't mean you won't get hurt, especially if you tumble from a high spot.
- **6. Swing safely.** Kids often get hurt at the playground because they get hit by someone on a swing. If you're swinging, watch out for people who

might be getting too close. And if you're walking around the playground, don't get too close to the swingers.

- 7. Use your head. Sometimes you'll see kids going headfirst down the slide or maybe two or three kids will get on a piece of equipment that's only meant for one. Or some kids might start goofing around and trying to push each other off a swing or off of a high spot. If your grown-up sees you doing this, he or she will probably say, "Knock it off. Someone's going to get hurt." It's true, so try to use the playground equipment properly. And if you get stuck, or don't know how to get down from something, call your grown-up over so he or she can help you down.
- **8. Report problems.** If you see graffiti (when people write or paint on stuff), a broken swing, or find any other problems while you're playing, tell your grown-up. He or she can report the problem so it can be fixed.
- **9. Clean up.** If you bring a drink or snack to the playground, clean up your trash before you leave. When you do, the park will look nice when the next kid comes along to play and you will have shown that you're a good playground citizen.
- **10.Have a great time!** How can you make a good time at the playground even better? Bring a friend and only complain a little when it's time to leave.
