Winchester Country Flag Day

What exactly is Flag Day? Flag Day is celebrated on June 14th. It commemorates the adoption of the flag of the United States, which happened that day by resolution of the Second Continental Congress in 1777. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that officially established June 14 as Flag Day; in August 1949, National Flag Day was established by an Act of Congress. One of the longest-running Flag Day parades is held annually in Quincy, Massachusetts, which begin in 1952 and celebrated its 57th year in 2009. The largest Flag Day parade is held annually in Troy, New York,

which bases its parade on the Quincy parade and typically draws 50,000 spectators. The week of June 14 is designated as "National Flag Week." During National Flag week, the president will issue a proclamation urging U.S. citizens to fly the American flag for the duration of that buildings.

The Famous Flag

As many people already know Betsy Ross created the Flag of the United States. But how much more that history do you know? The Betsy Ross flag is an early design of the flag of the United States



popularly attributed to Betsy Ross using the common motifs of alternating red-and-white striped field with white stars in a blue canton. The flag was designed during the American Revolution and features 13 stars to represent the original 13 colonies. The distinctive feature of the Ross flag is the arrangement of the five-pointed starts in a circle. The original flag was made on July 4, 1776, when a small committee—including George Washington and George Ross, a relative of hers-visited Betsy and discussed the need for a new American flag. June 14, 1777, the Second Continental Congress passed the Flag Resolution, establishing the first congressional standard for official United States flags. The flag of the United States has hence been changed from the thirteen stars to fifty stars to represent the fifty American states.

FATHER'S Day

Father's Day is on the third Sunday of June. This year, Father's Day is on June 20, 2010. Father's Day is a day to spend honoring all fathers. THANKS TO ALL THE DADS FOR BEING A FATHER TO THEIR CHILDREN. Many people probably don't know that the first celebration of father's day was in Spokane, Washington on June 19, 1910. Modern Father's Day was invented by Mrs. Sonora Smart Dodd. Her father, the civil war veteran William Jackson Smart, was a single parent who reared his six children in Spokane, Washington. She was inspired by Anna Jarvis's efforts to establish Mother's Day. Although she initially suggested June 5, her father's birthday, she did not provide the organizers with enough time to make arrangements, and the celebration was deferred to the third Sunday of June. President Calvin Coolidge recommended it as a national holiday in 1924. In 1966, President Lyndon Johnson made Father's Day a holiday to be celebrated on the third Sunday of June. The holiday was not officially recognized until 1972, during the presidency of Richard Nixon.

A Random Holiday

Many of you probably didn't know but parents and grandparents aren't the only ones who have a holiday celebrated for them. Children's day was first observed in the United States predate both Mother's and Father's Day. However, Children's day is not celebrated in the United States anymore. Many parents claim that "every day is Children's day", though this is not strictly true. The celebration of a special Children's Day in America dates from the 1860s and earlier. Children and Youth day in Hawaii started in 1994, when Hawaii because the first Legislature to pass a law to recognize the first Sunday in October as "Children's Day." In 1997, the Legislature passed another landmark law designating the entire month of October as "Children and Youth Month." Children's Day was proclaimed by President Bill Clinton to be held on October 8, 2000. "National Child's Day" was proclaimed by President George W. Bush as June 3, 2001 and in subsequent years on the first Sunday in June. In 2007, Illinois Governor Rod R. Blagojevich issued a proclamation proclaiming the second Sunday in June as Children's Day. The mayors of Aurora and Batavia, Illinois, also issued proclamations. In May 2009, International Children's Day was celebrated at the Washington DC National Harbor place. Even Children get a day to be celebrated, just as mom, dad, and grandparents. So remember to celebrate your kids on the second Sunday in June and read them this to remind them that they used to have a holiday, until parents felt that every day was their day.

The first day of summer will begin on June 21, 2010 at 7:23am. Have you ever wonder what effects the summer solstice has? Well, if you have been watching the sun each day leading up to the summer solstice, you will see that it climbs higher in the sky each day. On the day of the solstice, which marks the first official day of summer, the sun appears to stand still. It has reached as far north as it will get. The word "solstice" means the sun stands still. This is also true for the winter solstice, when the sun gets as far south in the sky before coming to a stop. Many people believe that the first day of summer is the longest day of the year. This

is because people believe that there is more sunlight on this day than any other. It is true that the days have been getting longer and the nights shorter. The sun is higher in the sky and takes a longer path across our sky, giving us more daylight. Therefore, with that, combined with more direct rays of sunshine, give us the warm summer season.

Kecipe of the Month

Black Bean Shrimp Salad

pound cooked medium shrimp, peeled and deveined
 can (15 ounces) black beans, rinsed and drained
 small green pepper, julienned
 small onion, thinly sliced
 cup chopped celery
 cup picante sauce
 tablespoons minced fresh cilantro

2 tablespoons lime juice
2 tablespoons olive oil
2 tablespoons honey
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/8 teaspoon grated lime peel, optional
6 lettuce leaves
1 cup halved cherry tomatoes

In a large bowl, combine the first five ingredients. In a small bowl, whisk the picante sauce, cilantro, lime juice, oil, honey, salt and lime peel if desired. Pour over shrimp mixture and toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate for at least 2 hours. Using a slotted spoon, spoon onto a lettuce-lined serving platter or salad plates. Garnish with tomatoes. Yield: 6 servings.

Winchester Country Pool Rules 2010

- 1. All rules apply to Adults and Children.
- 2. Only registered Winchester Country and Winchester Meadows residents and their guests will be allowed to use the pool. Maintenance fees must be current and pool registration must be on file in Guard office at the pool.
- 3. All guests will be charged \$1 daily and may be issued a guest pass that must be returned upon leaving.
- 4. The telephone located in Guard's Offie and Guard Check-in Station is for emergency use only.
- 5. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older.)
- 6. The baby pool is restricted to non-swimming children who are under the age of 5.
- 7. Non-swimming children must stay in the baby pool and within arm's reach of an adult. This also goes for the large pool. Only 2 non-swimmers per adult will be allowed.
- 8. All non-potty trained children must wear swim diapers at all times provided by the Resident.
- 9. Parents or Guardian are responsible for children and/or guests in both the baby pool and large pool at all times.
- 10. Running is not allowed in the pool area. No horeseplay will be tolerated either in or out of the water.
- 11. Glassware/glass containers are not allowed in the pool area. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area. Users of the pool are responsible to clean their area and use facility trashcans to discard their trash.
- 12. Abusive/offensive language or gestures and music with inappropriate lyrics will not be tolerated.
- 13. Smoking is not allowed in the fenced area of the pool facility. There are designated smoking areas in front of the Coordinator office and Clubhouse II.
- 14. All persons younger than 18 years of age will leave the water during the scheduled hourly Lifeguard break/Adult swim period and sit away from the pool edge. Adults at least 18 years of age can swim at their own risk at this break time.

- 16. Only Coast Guard approved floatation devices will be allowed and must be approved by the lifeguard staff. All non-swimmers must wear Coast guard approved floatation devices.
- 17. Persons with bandages and/or open sores will not be allowed in the pool.
- 18. Cocoa butter, baby oil or other simalr products will not be allowed in the pool. Commercial suntan preparations only.
- 19. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- 20. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen items or unclaimed items on the "Lost & Found" shelf. Unclaimed items will be disposed of throughtout the pool season.
- 21. No climbing on shade awning support poles or perimeter fencing.
- 22. The lifeguards on duty will have the final authority for the enforcement of pool rules and the overal safe operation of the facility both explicit and implied by the Pool Rules and must be obeyed at all times.

Discipline

Infractions to pool rules will result in disciplinary action taken by the contracted pool Management Company and/or Winchester Country Board of Directors. Disciplinary actions may include time out and/or the suspension of cards from one day up to and including the remainder of the pool season.

Tennis Court Cards

Our tennis court gate has been fixed. If your tennis card does not work please contact Joanna Abbondandolo at 281-890-8856. If you wish to obtain a tennis court card there is a \$10 deposit. You can either mail a check (made payable to WCMA) to WCMA, 9607 Rio Grande, Houston, Texas 77064 or you can drop off your check in the mail box slot located outside the clubhouse office. Please write in the memo line of your check "tennis card." Please include your mailing address. Your card will be mailed to you. If you would rather pick up your card you can stop by the Community Coordinator's office during office hours.
