#### **Council Person Corner**

As we head into the summer I want to give you a snap shot of some of the exciting things going on in the City of Pearland.

- In June, after months of hard work, the Westside Library substation opened at the Westside Event Center. This facility is a first step toward achieving the goal of a full service, first class library facility on the Westside of Pearland. The substation will allow residents to pick up and drop off books ordered via the library website (www.bcls.lib.tx.us). In addition, library patrons will be able to get library cards, pay fines and request items at the facility. The pick-up location will be open Monday and Wednesday evenings from 3-8 p.m. and Friday and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. A book drop will be available 24/7 for patrons to return all library materials. Throughout the summer, the library will offer a wide range of children's programs
- including story and craft times and special performers.
- The new Public Safety Building is now open on Cullen. The Public Safety Building houses the Police Department and the Municipal Court. You can also pay your water bill at this location and Brazoria County will offer some services at the facility as well. The building is LEED Certified Green which means the building was created using advanced energy efficient standards which will save a significant amount of taxpayer money over time.
- Later this summer the Recreation Center and Natatorium located on the corner of Bailey and Veterans Drive will open. The 107,000 square foot facility will include a gymnasium, weight room, dance/aerobics room, racquetball courts, locker rooms and an elevated story indoor track. It will also house a multipurpose room, kitchen and a drop-in play area for children. Inside

- the natatorium is a 50-meter pool, two 3-meter diving boards, two 1-meter diving boards and a warm-up pool complete with a zero depth entry. For more information visit www.pearlandparks.com.
- In August classes will begin at the University
  of Houston-Clear Lake Pearland Campus
  located on Pearland Parkway. Students
  will be able to complete junior, senior
  and graduate courses at the Campus in
  disciplines such as business, education and

A majority of people overestimate their own and their child's ability to swim, especially in a panic event.

Drowning occurs in as little as 2 minutes.



Irreversible brain damage occurs in as little as 4 minutes.



Most children are out of sight or missing for less than 5 minutes and usually in the presence of 1 or both parents.


#### **BROOK GLEN NEWS**

One of the topics of our monthly meetings involved notification of residents should an unexpected event occur that would negatively impact the community outside of the facility boundary limits. One of the key areas of notification is called First Call (http:// www.firstcall.net). This is an automated telephone notification system that provides instructions for those residences within the impacted areas depending on proximity, environmental conditions, and severity of the event. For those of you with published phone numbers you should already be on the list. For those of you that have unpublished numbers or want to ensure inclusion in the program, you can visit the website to register your phone number.
