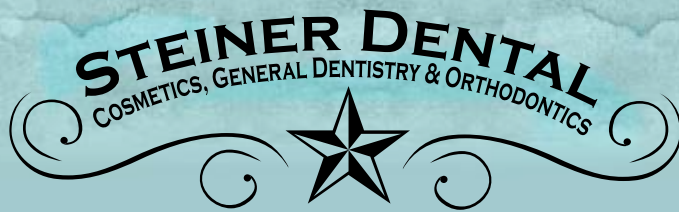

# AquaPalooza

Sea Ray Boats and its dealer Sail & Ski Center announced that an estimated 7,000 boats and 65,000 to 70,000 people attended Brad Paisley's concert on Saturday, July 10, at the AquaPalooza 2010 Signature Event on Lake Travis near Austin, Texas.

The event, held at The Reserve on Lake Travis, broke all previous Signature Event attendance records. This year's Signature Event attendance numbers are a compilation of on-site estimates by state and local officials, online registrations, and aerial comparisons and calculations. This year's results are nearly double last year's record-setting event.

# TENNIS ON THE CITY COURTS

The City of Lakeway's tennis courts have been resurfaced, with "U.S. Open Blue" coating and look great. The courts are on Lakeway Drive (next to the Live Oak golf driving range).

You are invited to join the Lakeway Tennis Tigers. To "join", just show up at 8:30 a.m. with a tennis racquet on any Saturday morning. There is no requirement for membership in any other organization, and there is no cost, but there is a lot of fun. This is social co-ed tennis, so don't expect heated competition. It is best suited for adults with at least basic tennis skills. There usually are a few ringers, but they get to be partners of someone who isn't so advanced.

The Live Oak Tennis Courts are maintained by the City of Lakeway for residents and guests. The courts are reserved for organized play for all interested players between 8:30 a.m. and 10 a.m. on Saturdays. The current City volunteer organizing the play is Fred Newton. When he is not there, one of the other regulars handle the



organization. At other times during the week, the courts are available on a first come, first served basis, or a court may be reserved for a small fee at the Lakeway Activity Center.

Don't let "organization" be confused with formality. The Saturday morning organization is just a means of getting everyone on court. This is done by various rotation schemes when there are more people than court space or if there is an odd number of players. At 9 a.m. and 9:30 a.m., a whistle is blown and players are rotated. This provides opportunities to meet other players.

At 10 a.m., play ceases. We go to the Signature Café in Randalls where we are joined on the deck by non-playing spouses, friends, and players who couldn't get up early enough to play. This provides an opportunity to brag on how good the play was, give excuses, or discuss topics of the day. Most of the players are in foursomes during the week and look to this gathering to arrange substitutions or set up matches.

## HERITAGE CENTER BEGINS

### *Annual Search for Lakeway War Veterans*

The Lakeway Heritage Center is seeking local residents who are now serving or who have served in the Iraq or Afghanistan wars, or those who served during the Gulf War, Vietnam, Korea, or World War II, who have not yet had their names engraved on the Heritage Park *Spirit of Freedom Monument*. Applications for engraving may be obtained at the entry to monument, or by contacting the Heritage Center via email at [history@lakeway-tx.gov](mailto:history@lakeway-tx.gov).

The deadline for submitting an application will be Friday, August 13, 2010. Formal recognition of those veterans will be at 11 a.m. on Veterans Day, Thursday, November 11, 2010.

There is no additional space on the World War II obelisk for former army veterans. Former World War II navy veterans should visit the monument due to limited space available. There is no space limitation for veterans who served in other branches of the military – including the Army Air Corps – or during subsequent periods of armed conflict.

A tax-deductible donation of \$150.00 is requested for each name to be engraved. Questions concerning the process or the monument will be answered by either calling the Heritage Center at 512-608-9533 Monday, Wednesday, or Friday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. or by fax at 512-608-9537. 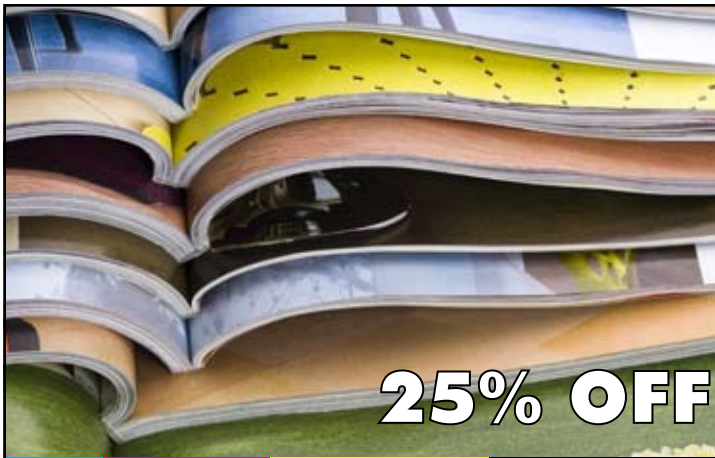
