Compass Corner By Paul Hicks

Ladies and Gentlemen, Neighbors and Countrymen, your Compass Corner has some good news for you! During the most recent MUD 281 meeting, our accountant in conjunction with our investment advisor have notified MUD 281 that we are in fantastic financial shape and therefore we will be allowed to consider a property tax rate reduction. As such, after much discussion, the Directors are recommending a 5 cent reduction on the tax rate from \$1.10 per \$100 valuation to \$1.05. I know it doesn't sound like much, but when you consider that Villages of NorthPointe has now reached that

critical mass where this is even possible, it's big news indeed. We fully expect to have another rate reduction next year upon review of the numbers at that time and we will continue to review in future years. This decision is based on the tax base of all homes in Villages of NorthPointe and the continuing sales of approximately 4-6 new homes per month. So even with a slight reduction in the appraised value of homes in VNP, the new home sales have more than offset the difference. As Section 15 begins home construction we will see an even greater contribution to the tax base as we go forward. Our only concern over the past two years has been the bond rating that we enjoy which allows MUD 281 to get the most favorable bond sales possible has been terrific. The higher the bond rating, the lower the costs to tax payers. We are now at the point where our bond rating will not be affected by a reduction in the tax rate and as long as that continues, we will do what we can to keep this ball rolling. Once again, if any of you are interested in joining us at the next MUD meeting or would like further details, please contact me at paul@paulhicksrealtor.com. The only other information for you this month is that the apartment complex (which we don't need) I mentioned last month that is possibly going in behind the old Wachovia location on NorthPointe at 249 looks to be going very slowly, if at all. There have been some additional inquiries on that same property from other developers, possibly for a shopping center (which we do need). I'll keep my ears open on this one and let you know what develops. I close with the following one-liner nonsense to test your funny bones:

Pearl Fincher Museum of Fine Arts

"Where Art is Just the Start!"

The Pearl Fincher Museum of Fine Arts is located at 6815 Cypresswood Drive near the intersection of Stuebner Airline and Cypresswood Drive next to the Barbara Bush Branch Library. It opened in March 2008, in partnership with the Museum of Fine Arts in Houston, and other private and public lenders to bring world-class art exhibitions to Northwest Houston. Admission is free of charge, but a \$3.00 donation is suggested.



The Pearl complements its exhibitions with an active schedule of programs and services. Founded on the community center concept, the Pearl reaches beyond traditional museums to enlighten, educate and entertain. Hours of operation and more information is on their website at www.pearlmfa.org or you may call the museum staff at 281-376-6322.

Their unique Fall 2010 Exhibitions are open until December 19th. The Grand Tour: British and French Portraits from a Texas Collection. This private Texas collection of twenty-two English, French, American and German portraits of the 17th, 18th and 19th centuries traces the history of portraiture in France and Great Britain over three centuries, from the Grand Manner style of the court of Charles I in England and the French courts, to the smaller, more intimate portraits and figure studies of the mid to late 19th century. A View of the World: British Watercolor Artists at Home and Abroad is a wonderful private

Texas collection of 19th and 20th century watercolors by British artists. The artists in this exhibition painted both 'at home' with views of scenic English countryside, thatched cottages, rural villages and architectural landmarks such as cathedrals. However, British watercolor artists also embraced painting 'abroad' using the portable medium of watercolor for studies of the brilliant light of the Middle East, the architecture of the European Continent, and other sights around the world.
