efficiency arena, so I took a leap of faith and started another new company. This leads to where I am today.

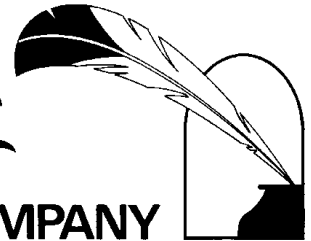
