DIRECTIONS:

for cupcakes

1-box devil's food cake mix

Chocolate candy sprinkles

• Heat oven to 350 degrees

• 2-containers (1lb each) milk chocolate

• 1-tube(4.25 oz) white decorating icing

• 1-tube (0.68) oz) brown decorating gel

• Make and cool cake as directed on box

• Frost cupcakes with the frosting.

Turkey Cupcakes

• Put the remaining frosting in corner of resealable freezer plastic bag.

Recipe of the Month

- Snip off small corner of the bag.
- To decorate each cupcake, pipe 1-inch mound of frosting on 1 side of cupcake to look like head of the turkey.
- Make the eyes with the white decorating icing and brown decorating gel; add candy corn for beak.
- To make feathers, pipe frosting on opposite side to hold candy corn; place candy corn upright on frosting to look like feathers.
- Sprinkle chocolate candy sprinkles near

TIPS: BURGLARY PREVENTION AND PROTECTION

- going to be away (even overnight).
- Use your alarm system (if applicable)
- Inventory your home (record serial numbers or electronics, firearms, bicycles, etc. Take photos of jewelry) keep the records in a safe place and file a copy with your homeowner's insurance. This helps increase the chances of recovering your property and securing a conviction when the suspects are caught.
- Use your exterior lighting at night!! A well lighted home is an unattractive target.
- Park your vehicles in your garages (if possible) and in the driveway (when not)
- Lock your vehicles and do not leave valuables in the car at anytime. (It took less than 1.5 Minutes for a purse to be stolen from a vehicle locked and parked at a school in view of the complainant while she was picking up her children while she was out of her vehicle)
- Make arrangements for someone to pick up your mail and paper while your are away.
- If someone knocks on your door, acknowledge them (not necessarily opening the door) speak to them through the door, if you don't know them advise them your are calling the constable's office.

- Please use the precinct 5 vacation watch for your home if you are Stagger your light timers in different rooms to make the house look occupied while you are away.
 - Have a neighbor check on your home daily and let those as well as the constable's (vacation watch) know of service companies (day / company name / etc) that will be at your home while you are away.
 - Use your sprinkler system as a deterrent at night set them to go off sometime between 2am-5am.
 - · Keep shrubs and trees trimmed around windows so a burglar cannot hide behind them to break into your home.
 - These are but a few practices to help keep your home safe. Thanks for your attention

Jour Pets! If you happen to come across vicious dogs, or ANY loose dogs of this nature, please contact your local sheriff's department 281-463-6666, Animal Control at 281-999-3191. If you are familiar with the property address the pets belong to, please feel free to submit that information to PCMI - Sarah Hudson at shudson@stes.com - to pursue the deed restriction violation. Notification and ample time must be given to the owner to correct the violation prior to any further pursuit by the Association.

It is a deed restriction violation if your pets are not confined to a fenced backyard or within your home. They must not be allowed to bark all night or cause a nuisance to your neighbors. They must also be on a leash at all times when not in a contained environment. It is also the pet owner's responsibility to keep ALL areas of the community FREE from pet debris when walking your pets. PLEASE REMEMBER THAT CATS MUST ALSO BE CONFINED.
