National Night Out *A Success!*

National Night Out (NNO) 2010 was celebrated by at least 10 neighborhoods of Silverlake on Tuesday Oct 5. With gatherings at the new Stonebridge Park as well as in neighborhood cul de sacs and streets, residents gathered outside to socialize with neighbors new and old while enjoying food and drinks. For Weatherford residents, it was their 4th Annual National Night Out. More than 70 residents attended the event. The Pearland Police Department, McGruff the Crime Dog, Brazoria County Sheriff's Office, and Pearland EMS visited some neighborhoods, including Weatherford and Woodbend. The Manvel Fire Dept. visited the gathering at Stonebridge Park.

NNO is a community building campaign designed to:

- 1) Heighten crime prevention awareness;
- 2) Generate support for, and participation in, local anti-crime programs;
- 3) Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships; and
- 4) Send a message to criminals that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back!

Marylee Olson and Lanette Earnest of Weatherford began a grassroots Neighborhood Watch Program in the subdivision in 2008, after a home invasion and other crime shocked the area. The ladies maintain an updated database of more than 100 homes residents' phone numbers and e-mail addresses, and can quickly share emergency information to residents. Blocks within the neighborhood have assigned Captains, who maintain close contact with the neighbors on their block.

Well, the mid-terms and the highly visible gubernatorial race are finally here. We are seeing more and more candidate signs appearing in our neighbors' front yards, not to mention the hundreds that are showing up along the roadways. So what does that mean to you? It means – get out and vote!

You might think that your one vote is not going to matter in the grand scheme of things; there's nothing that can be further from the truth. It is your duty as a citizen of this great country to get out and vote.

Your vote affects a lot of things, such as:

1. How your money is spent by county commissioners, the governor and state legislatures and the members of congress;

The polling locations are open as follows:

October 18th – October 22nd	8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
October 23rd	7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
October 24th	1:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.
October 25th – October 29th	7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Election Day is Tuesday, November 2, 2010. On that day, voters will need to vote in their precinct locations. Silverlake is comprised of four different precincts: Precinct 58, Precinct 60, Precinct 63 and Precinct 75. Polls on Election Day will be open from 7:00 a.m. through 7:00 p.m. If you choose to vote on Election Day, please go to the appropriate location.

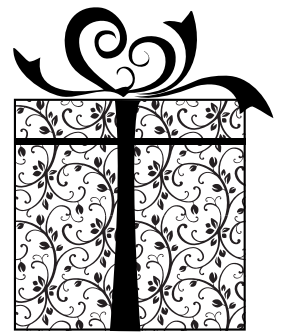

ASK THE COACH

Dear Coach,

I am overwhelmed when I go into the local vitamin/supplement store. I am looking for something to help me speed up my results of my diet. Do you recommend anything?

Dear Overwhelmed,

I am very wary of supplements. It is not regulated by the FDA and there are many cases where there are undocumented ingredients in the supplements. For example, steroids in the "MEGA" can of protein or dangerous chemicals like ephedra which has been linked to serious side effects.

I try to use more natural products. Right now I am using chia seeds as my snack food of choice. Yes, this is the same stuff as the chia pets, but it is very high in fiber, omega 3, omega 6, etc. It is a great post workout food because it has both carbohydrates and the necessary proteins needed after a workout to assist in muscle recovery. In addition, it is a great source of fiber so you will feel less hungry. I have even cut coffee out of my diet since using them. As with any changes to your diet, you should talk with your doctor or nutritionist to see if there are any possible side effects.

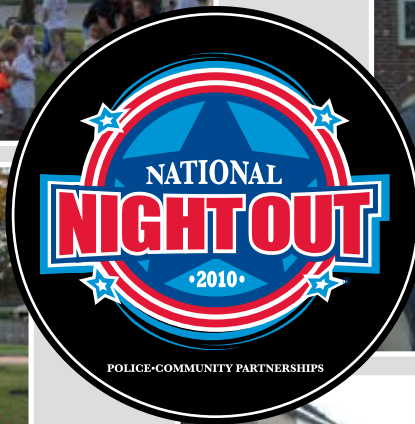
