# **Turning New Years Resolutions** Into ALL Year Resolutions

January is here, and so is the tradition of making New Year's Resolutions. And many times, the tradition of breaking those resolutions. We find ourselves excited and motivated for the start of a new year, and within a few months we often experience frustration because we simply cannot stick with the resolutions we set.

I have been teaching fitness classes, personal training, and coordinating fitness programs for over a decade, and I see it every year. Gyms are packed from January through March, and then many members just seem to disappear or give up.

Here is my question. What can we do to stick with exercise and making healthy choices for twelve months out of the year instead of just three? It is not easy, but laying a proper and realistic foundation is the key. And remembering that if we do fall off the wagon, we need to hop right back on and not give up. As I have outlined in some of my previous articles, commitment, time management, setting measurable goals, and by Sarah S. Jordan, MS

being realistic are all vital components to our success.

If a sedentary and overweight client begins training with me and says, "My goal is to lose 50 pounds in five weeks," that client is sure to fail before she even begins. That rate of weight loss is simply not healthy, realistic, or lasting. However, if the same client says, "My goal is to workout three days a week for 20-50 minutes each time and as a result, lose 50 pounds this year," she is off to a great start! That goal is specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, and time-bound.

People often ask me what my New Year's resolutions are, and to be honest, I don't really set them anymore. You see... I, too, have set resolutions many times in the past, and within weeks or months felt defeated and gave up because they were not realistic. Instead, I find myself setting little goals throughout the year, but they very rarely include numbers on a scale.

Setting "number goals" (ex: "I want to lose 20 pounds by May") certainly has its merit,

# Here Are A Few Tips To Setting All Year Resolutions.

- Set S.M.A.R.T. goals. They should be specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, and timely.
- Find what works for YOU. If joining a gym is not realistic for you, find other

activities, classes, and opportunities that don't involve a gym membership.

- Get support. That could be a close friend, spouse, personal trainer, meet up group, or coworker. Communicate your goals and have people in your corner cheering you on.

First, In order to recycle your tree do not get a tree with flocking or add flocking to your tree. Please remove your tree from the stand, remove all tinsel, lights and ornaments.

### OPTION ONE for those of you who want to help restore our "Brazoria County" sand dunes you have to do this from December 28, 2010 to January 13, 2011:

Bring your Christmas tree to the Stella Roberts Recycling Center, 5800 Magnolia Dr., Pearland, TX 77584 during the centers operating hours. The Center is open Monday trough Friday from noon to 5pm and Saturday 9am to 1pm. The Center will be closed December 24, 25, 27, 2010 and January 3, 2011 for the holidays. Trees will also be accepted at the Brazoria County Precinct 2 Work Yard 7315 Corporate Dr, Manvel, TX Monday-Thursday 7:30AM-5:30PM. It is behind the Brazoria County Service Center (turn onto Corporate drive and pass the service center building). Trees collected at these sites in Pearland and Manvel will be used for the Brazoria County Dune Project on January 15, 2011. At 9:00AM Volunteers will meet at Quintana Beach County Park and Stahlman Park, Surfside to rebuild, restore and strengthen our dune line against storm surges. There will be a lunch following the staking of the trees. For more information about where to drop off your tree call our offices (281-652-1659). ### OPTION TWO if you can't transport your tree, you live in a single family dwelling and you are within Pearland City of limits.

Your tree can be set out curbside on your Green Waste Day (second trash day of the week). These trees will go to a commercial composting facility or chopped up for mulch at the facility along with the rest of your green waste.

### **Homeowner Tips**

# In case you haven't already remember to do a little house keeping this winter season.

- 1. Clean the vents behind your dyer in the beginning of winter. Remember you are drying heavier clothes at this time of the year so more lint will be generated. There are kits you can find in the hardware store to assist you with this. If the vents are clean then clothes will dry quicker and lower the risk of a fire.
- 2. Check your furnace filter a least once a month during the heating season. You want to check for excess dust. You may want to change it once or twice a year so that it operates more efficiently. You can also ask your A/C and Heating professional to help you with this.
- 3. Vacuum the refrigerator condenser coils. They are usually located on the bottom or on the back of the fridge. Be sure to unplug it first then use your vacuum's brush attachment to remove the dust or lint build-up or other debris.
- 4. Check the expiration date on your fire extinguishers and make sure they haven't expired. Be sure to replace ground fault outlet circuit interrupters that aren't working properly. All items needing to be replaced can be purchased at your local hardware store.
- 5. Check to make sure your smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are working properly. You are supposed to change the batteries twice a year, but most people forget. An easy way to remember is to do it when the time changes in the spring and in the fall. They even have a product in the hardware store that is designed to aid you in testing your detectors.
