

This spring the Villages of NorthPointe will offer a community summer league swim team--the NorthPointe Shockwaves. Shockwaves is an NWAL (Northwest Aquatic League) sponsored team and will compete throughout May and June against other area teams. Shockwaves is open to all swimmers 4 through 18 years-old, regardless of previous experience or ability. Our youngest swimmers will need to be "water-safe" as determined by our coaching staff. If concerned about a young swimmer's ability, see our website for helpful information to determine readiness.
