
In an article I wrote back in November and will repeat here is similar to the above but we also have a website and these are worthy of repeating -

You can of course visit with your block captain but only after you make this first contact.

Finally, we are having a meeting in a few weeks and will meet with another Landscape Designer to work on the front of our subdivision. The 1st interview we had was unsuccessful because that prospect wanted a contract before we did any planning, drawing, sharing of ideas or anything. We want a partner who will work with us and our budget to get the best value for our money and have a good lucking and functional entrance we can all be proud of.

Neighborhood Watch

By the time you read this, we will have had our first block captain meeting of the year. We have 3 or 4 per year. Each meeting is an opportunity for the block captains to communicate with each other. The Wortham neighborhood has several long streets. We try to cover them with more than one block captain. The truth is that we never have enough block captains, so if you see a few names already listed for your street, feel free to join in. The benefits are that you meet more neighbors, get a feel for what is going on in the neighborhood and in return it costs you time for 3 or 4 short meetings per year (maximally an hour each). We also hope that you will help out with National Night Out in October, which has been a very successful neighborhood activity.

This year we are working on updating an email list of all neighbors. This is the fastest and best way to communicate with most of our neighbors. If you have changed your email, please let your block captain know (or Shawn or Herman). We will only use that to communicate neighborhood news.

Last Thursday, Shawn and Herman attended our first session (of 13 weeks) of the Citizens Police Academy, sponsored by the Harris County Sheriff. This looks like a great set of classes that will help us appreciate the work that is done by the Harris County Sheriff's office and give us more information on working on problems that

may occur in our neighborhood.

We are fortunate in that we have a quiet neighborhood. Sometimes unpleasant things do happen. That is why we have a neighborhood watch and why we encourage all neighbors to call the sheriff (713 221 6000; for emergencies dial 911) if they see any suspicious activity.

The next paragraph is from one of our neighbors who lost decorations at Christmas.

"Our house was one of those houses hit by the criminal mischief during Christmas. Since we lost decorations that can never be replaced, we felt the need to take down everything. We had so much fun putting all our decorations out, remembering the days when we had nothing and how each year we added items. Some of our blowmolds were 40 yrs old. But what made our day was the nice people that stopped and commented on our yard...the little boy down the street made his mother walk several times that first day to see what all we had put up...he was so excited. People stopped to take pictures in the few weeks we had everything up. Then it all had to come down....a very sad day. People stopped to asked what had happened...It really upset my mother the most. She loves to decorate for all the seasons, sharing her joy with others, and now is



Northwest Flyers Youth Track Club Information Sessions


THURSDAY EVENING, APRIL 7TH, 2011 AND FRIDAY EVENING, APRIL 22ND, 2011

The Northwest Flyers Track Club will host 2 open house/ registration sessions for all middle and high school athletes and their parents interested in joining for the 2011 season. The events will be held on Thursday, April 7, and Friday, April 22, from 7:00 - 8:30 PM in the Cypress Room at the Methodist Willowbrook Hospital, 18220 Tomball Parkway, Houston, at the corner of FM 1960 and Highway 249. The sessions will begin with a very important program overview/orientation at 7:00 PM. All interested athletes and parents should report on time.

The Northwest Flyers is a youth (ages 6 -18) track organization, affiliated with USA Track & Field. The club provides a full program of "track" events such as sprints, hurdles, middle distance, distance, relays and "field" events such as long jump, triple jump, high jump, pole vault, discus, shot put and javelin. It is an excellent "offseason" program for young athletes who currently compete on their middle school or high school varsity track teams.

The club was founded 24 years ago by Olympic gold medalist Fred Newhouse to foster the development of youth track & field in the Northwest Houston area. Last year the Northwest Flyers qualified 36 young athletes to compete at the US Junior Olympics National Championships in Sacramento, California.
