Whether you're traveling for business or pleasure, make your safety and security at your hotel a priority. Always follow these safety measures recommended by the American Hotel & Motel Association:

- Make every effort to stay only in those establishments that have deadbolt locks and a peephole in the door.
- Make sure that all windows and doors are securely locked, including connecting doors between rooms.
- Park in a well-lit area away from trucks, vans, dumpsters, open fields or woods.
- Do not discuss your room number within earshot of strangers and keep a close eye on your key.
- Use the hotel or room safe for valuables.
- Never answer your door without first looking through the peephole. Hotel employees will be in uniform, and be able to provide identification. When in doubt, phone the front desk to confirm the person's identity.
- When returning to your hotel in the evening, use the main entrance. If you sense that you are being followed, don't go directly to your room. If you have reason to believe you're in immediate danger, seek out hotel security personnel or activate the nearest fire alarm.

Some suggestions for protecting your personal property are:

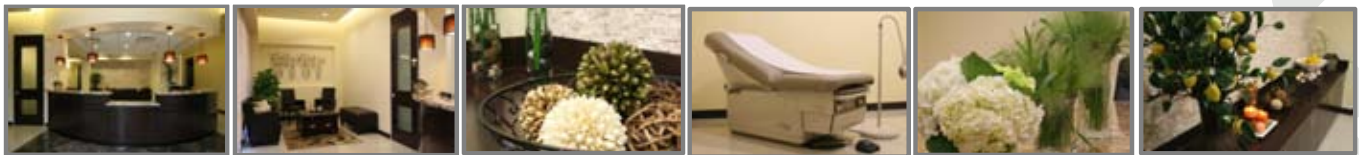
- Set your alarm system when you leave home.
- Use double key deadlocks on front and back doors. Intruders will select the doors that looks easiest to break into and that offers the least chance of being seen.
- Doors going into the garage and going from an attached garage into the house many times offer an intruder the opportunity to hide from view while they are breaking in. Extra thought should go into the security at these locations.
- Driveway monitors are quite inexpensive and are highly effective in notifying you of activity around your automobile during the night.

CONSTRUCTION AT SUMMERWOOD ENTRANCE IS UNDERWAY!

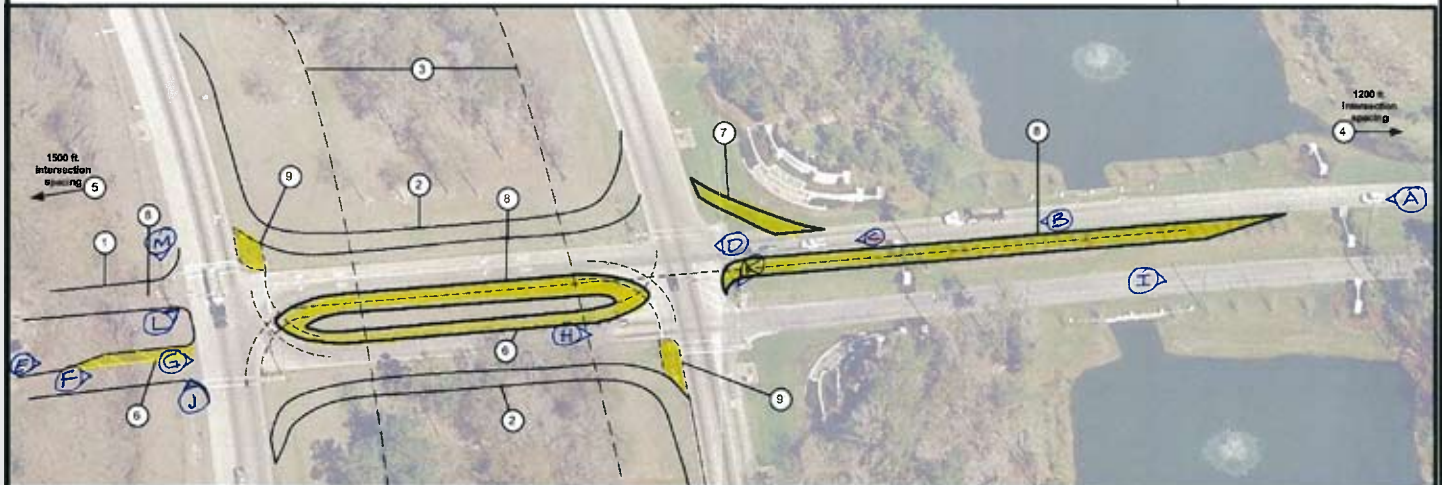
In late March 2011, the Association received details about the expansion project occurring at Summerwood's entrance. According to Harris County Architecture and Engineering-Capital I Projects Department, construction will begin the first week of May and should take 4-6 weeks. When the project is complete, there will be 4 lanes on the north side of West Lake Houston Parkway. The far 2 left lanes will turn left, the 3rd lane will be for straight traffic (to the high school), and the 4th lane will go straight or turn right.

Our Summerwood Monuments and much of our landscaping in the existing median will be removed with this project, but the Association will plant new shrubbery in the smaller median after the construction is complete. Harris County anticipates "the proposed roadway improvements will enhance mobility and reduce traffic delay for motorists on West Lake Houston Parkway, including those who live in Summerwood." All drivers are encouraged to drive carefully through the construction areas and to add a few extra minutes to their route during this time.

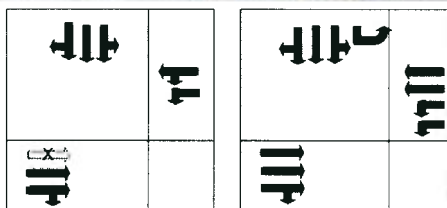

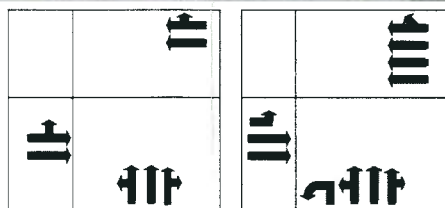

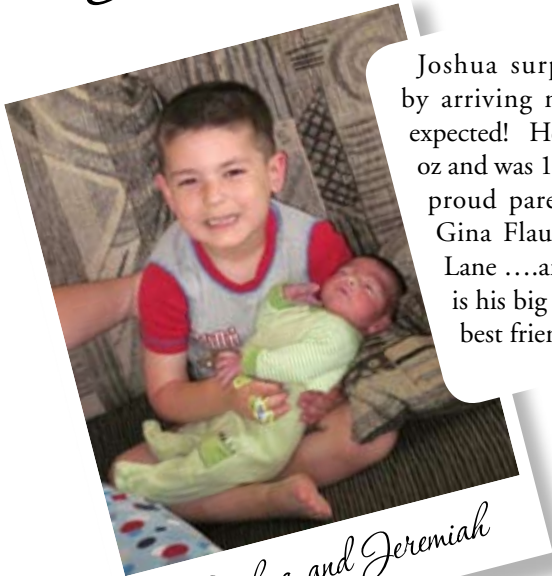
