NO Soliciting

The City of Colleyville has adopted a strict solicitation ordinance aimed at keeping citizens safe, protecting their privacy, and creating an outlet for complaints. There are now heightened permit requirements and limitations of hours between 9am and 4:30pm for solicitors.

Those who do not wish to be contacted by solicitors should post a "No Solicitation" sign that meets the city's requirements near the main entrance to their home. Signs must be not less than 3 inches by 4 inches in size, with letters not less than 2/3 of an inch in height.

We may look into getting a quantity of signs made for our residents. Perhaps we can get a quantity discount with a large order and make them available to residents at our next social events. If enough residents put up the signs, we may be able to make our neighborhood less attractive for solicitors.

- 4. Underlined dates indicate events. The events will be shown on the lower half of the calendar. For full detail on the event, click on the notepad icon next to the event name.
- 5. To print a copy of the monthly calendar, look for the action line at the very bottom of the screen and click on it.
