## **Book Club**

June's selection is also the "Mayor's Book" for Austin this year: **You Know When the Men Are Gone** by Siobhan Fallon. Fort Hood, the Army Base that serves as the launching pad for America's wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, is the stage for Ms. Fallon's book of loosely connected stories, which capture the real life drama and emotions of love and loss, struggle and survival, and celebration and despair within the lives of the women who wait for the return of the soldiers -- their soldier. One can learn much about the wars the country is engaged in through news reports, but in these stories, Fallon provides a view that has long been camouflaged.

Reviewers are uniform in their praise of the literary excellence displayed in this debut work by Ms. Fallon. One reviewer offers this tribute: "Siobhan Fallon's *You Know When the Men Are Gone* is a haunting elegy to those who bear the real burden when our nation goes to war: the spouses and children left behind . . .and this collection of stories has much to teach us all."

Looking ahead to July, check out this New York Times bestseller by Rebecca Skloot, *The Immortal Life of Henrietta Lacks*. Scientists know her as HeLa, a poor black tobacco farmer whose cells—

taken without her knowledge in 1951—became one of the most important tools in medicine, vital for developing the polio vaccine, cloning, gene mapping, in vitro fertilization, and more. Henrietta's cells have been bought and sold by the billions, yet she remains virtually unknown, and her family can't afford health insurance.

### DIRECTORY FORM WE WANT YOU !!!






