



Hurricane season is here until November 1st. We were spared any bad tropical weather in 2010 and hope for the same in 2011. Many of us remember in the not-so-distant past Hurricane Ike and Hurricane Rita that caused flooding and deadly traffic in our area. In order to prevent any last minute panic in case of hurricane force wind and rain, be sure to take advantage of all the web-based resources at your fingertips. One of the best is www. hcoem.org, which is the Harris County Office of Emergency Management. There are many links to hurricane preparedness brochures, traffic evacuation maps, and much more including videos of past hurricanes, as well as a video of Harris County if a disastrous hurricane strikes us directly.

At press time, we are still waiting on rain. However many of us remember Tropical Storm Allison in June 2001 when 30+ inches of rain fell in many parts of our area, 28 inches in just 12 hours! Houston had widespread flooding, which caused shutting down our Houston Medical Center district and much more devastation! The cost was \$5BILLION and lives were lost. The video on www.hcoem.org about the Category 5 Hurricane is very eye-opening and I encourage you to watch.


