Drinking Water Alert Confusion

A couple months ago there was a Boil Water Advisory issued for "Forest Creek" indicating a possible contaminated drinking water situation. Signs were posted on Links Lane and emails sent out. Confusion was created because the name of "Forest Creek" being used by the original Forest Creek of Round Rock (Forest Creek HOA/PUD-4) and the other Forest Creek development (FC-III HOA, apartments, and commercial) located just south of our Forest Creek but outside Round Rock city limits. The two "Forest Creek" communities are served by two different water suppliers.

Our Forest Creek development (Forest Creek HOA/PUD-4) is fully within the city limits of Round Rock and our water supply comes from the City of Round Rock. Each of you can verify this by simply looking at your water bill. The other Forest Creek development (FC-III, apartments and commercial) gets their water from a Municipal Utility District. If there were potential water contamination impacting the Forest Creek of Round Rock (Forest Creek HOA) then the City of Round Rock would issue the water advisory and post it on the Round Rock web site. Round Rock has an outstanding water quality history; the system is carefully managed and well monitored. If you see a Boil Water Advisory or read about it on the Forest Creek Yahoo site in the future, please verify which Forest Creek it is concerning by checking with the Round Rock web site http://www.roundrocktexas.gov, and help educate others by sharing this article with them.




