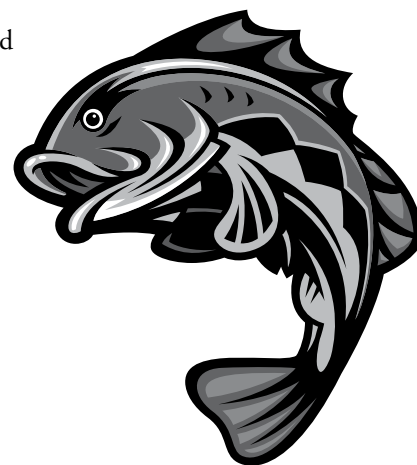
Park for prizes.

Harris County Precinct 4 Report for the ACIA

In my first meeting being in charge of security I met with Sergeant Lekas of the Harris County Constable Precinct 4, who is in charge of the ACIA constables, we had a very nice opened ended discussion. Sergeant Lekas has been in this area since 1993 and is very astute of what is going on in our area.

Some of the items in our discussion as homeowners were:

1. The use exterior lighting, just as long as it does not trespass on your neighbors. Use the photo cell bulbs as they do not cost much to light the area.
2. Know your neighbors, have their phone numbers for emergencies and vice versa.
3. Check your alarm system and make sure it is working, also know your password as there are only a few free false alarms and then afterwards one is charged for the call. Test the alarm every month.
4. As always do not leave valuables in your vehicle, especially where a thief can spot it. Be sure the doors are locked and if you have an alarm then set the alarm. It may save you the cost of a window replacement as well.
5. Don't forget about the new speed limit laws for 75 MPH; be sure the signs are posted as it does not include all highways and freeways.

I plan on meeting with Sergeant Lekas once a month so I will get to know what is going on in our community and not just communicate with emails.

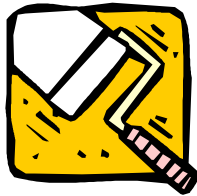

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Clam Chowder

INGREDIENTS

- 2/3 C diced salt pork
- 1 T butter
- 3 C diced onions
- 3/4 C common crackers
- 1 can clams
- 3 C diced potatoes
- 1 bay leaf
- 3 C milk or Half & Half
- salt & pepper



Place diced salt pork in 2 qts. simmering water. Boil slowly 5 mins. Rinse and drain. Saute slowly with butter for several minutes, until pork begins to brown. Stir in onions. Cover and cook slowly 8 to 10 minutes, until tender & translucent. Blend in crackers. Set aside. Drain clams, saving liquid. Add enough water to make 4 cups. Pour over onions. Add potatoes and bay leaf. Simmer, loosely covered, for 20 minutes.

Chop clams. Stir into soup along with milk. Bring to just below the simmer point. Salt & pepper.. (Allow chowder to season several hours or overnight.) Bring to just below the simmer point before serving. Don't boil - this will make clams tough.

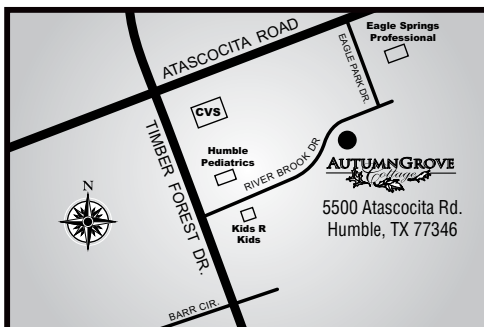
Our homelike environment is one of the cornerstones in the AutumnGrove Cottage belief that people should be able to age in the same manner they are accustomed to living.
