

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Please secure your trash so that it does not get blown away and litter the yards.
- Keep your grass cut, watered and fertilized.
- Check the Deed Restrictions before making changes.
- Volunteers are needed for various committees.
- The Harbour is your community paper, consider contributing an article.
- Be a good neighbor.
- Enjoy living in Chelsea Harbour and help keep it beautiful.

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Yard of The Month

Is your yard a Yard of the Month contender? Our community landscape committee will be choosing a yard of the month. The first recipient of this award will be honored in May. The yard of the month competition will run through December.

In October and November the committee will be choosing a winner for Fall Decorating Contest and in December for a Holiday Lighting Contest. Homeowners may nominate their own property or their neighbors. You will need to provide the address of the property

and the names of the residents if possible. Members of the selection committee are not eligible to be selected. Candidates will be judged solely on the total exterior appearance of their property and front yard as viewed from the street. General upkeep of the yard and property is paramount. Factors

shall include the overall appearance, tidiness, and neatness of the property.

Each judge will judge every yard nominated on a scale set by the committee. Winners will be expected to maintain their yard in the same manner in which allowed them to win the title. The yard of the month sign will be prominently displayed in the yard located midway between the street and the front of the house. The sign will be removed at months end to prepare for the next monthly winner.

This winner of Yard of The Month Contest will receive gift cards to Lowe's Home Improvement Store.

Judging Criteria:

- Mowed & neatly trimmed
- Sidewalks & driveways edged
- Curb & driveway cracks & crevices free of grass & weeds

- Minimal amount of weeds in lawn
- Flowers & vegetation are well landscaped, with good use of color
- All plantings must be living (no silk, plastic, or artificial plants)
- Debris (garbage, pet feces, etc.) shall be picked up and removed
- Trash carts not visible from the street
- Walkways and driveways clean and stain free
- Homeowner must be current with association dues
- Aesthetics; an overall inviting look from the front yard
- Clean, well maintained yards are not only pleasing, but contagious.....so catch the spirit and good luck!
